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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Methodology

In Fall 2002, a total of 30 In-Class surveys were completed by students in credit Collision Auto Repair courses – CAR 1100, CAR 1200, and CAR 1600. No surveys were received from students in the non-credit course, MEST 1017/CAR 1300 – Classic Auto Repair.

Limitations

- In order to compare Fall 2002 data to previous terms, the CAR surveys from Fall 2001 and Winter 2002 were re-coded to match the format of current In-Class Surveys. Due to coding issues in previous semesters, some percentages in this report may differ from previous reports. The data in all (100%) of the re-coded surveys have been verified. Therefore, the percentages in this report should be used when evaluating the findings from Fall 2001 and Winter 2002, and when comparing those semesters to future studies.
- As expected, caution should be used when interpreting the results due to low sample sizes.

Key Findings

- Although "personal interest" was the top reason cited for taking CAR courses during Fall of 2002, the percentage of students indicating that they took the course for personal reasons fell from 75% in Winter 2002 to 51.7% in Fall 2002. The second and third most popular reasons for taking the course were "to prepare for ASE National Certification exam" (34.5%), and "to see if I like the field" (24.1%).
- Two-thirds (66.7%) of CAR students planned to use the skills they acquired for personal reasons or hobby purposes, regardless of their reasons for taking the course.
- In Fall 2002, 43.3% of students learned about CAR courses from a college publication and 26.7% learned about the courses from a friend or family member. However, in both Fall 2001 and Winter 2002, more than 60% of students learned about courses from a friend or family member, and approximately 20% learned about the courses from their employer.

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- It should be noted that prior to becoming a credit program, CAR courses were not listed in OCC's catalog. Fall 2002 was the first term that students could learn about CAR courses from the OCC catalog.
- Since becoming a credit program, the CAR courses have attracted a more diverse group of students. This change in the CAR student profile may be partially attributable to (1) the attraction of students who seek credit-courses and/or award-granting programs; and (2) the increased exposure of CAR courses to a wider population of students since appearing in the course catalog.

- Similar to previous terms, the vast majority (86.7%) of Fall 2002 CAR students were employed. However, they were less likely than students from previous terms to be employed in jobs related to the automotive repair industry. Approximately half (53.9%) of employed students worked in jobs that were somewhat or highly related to automotive repair, compared to more than 70% of students in the previous two semesters.
- Forty-three percent (43.3%) of students planned to obtain a certificate in Collision Auto Repair, while 23.3% plan to take a few more CAR courses.
- Most (73.3%) of the students in the Fall 2002 courses attended auto shows on a regular basis. Half (50.0%) read the automotive section of the newspaper on a regular basis, and 40% restored antique/classic cars. Onethird (33.3%) read Hot Rod Magazine.

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- Many students purchased their automotive supplies from multiple places. In Fall 2002, the most frequently mentioned retailers included Auto Zone (23.8%) and Murray's (19.0%).
- When asked why they chose to attend OCC for their CAR courses, 37.5% of Fall 2002 students cited reasons pertaining to location (i.e., close to home, close to work, etc.).
