This report is based on each course section's official count date (1/10th Day). The Credit Hour Trends report examines annual (July 1 - June 30) enrollment trends of OCC disciplines, based on course prefix codes.

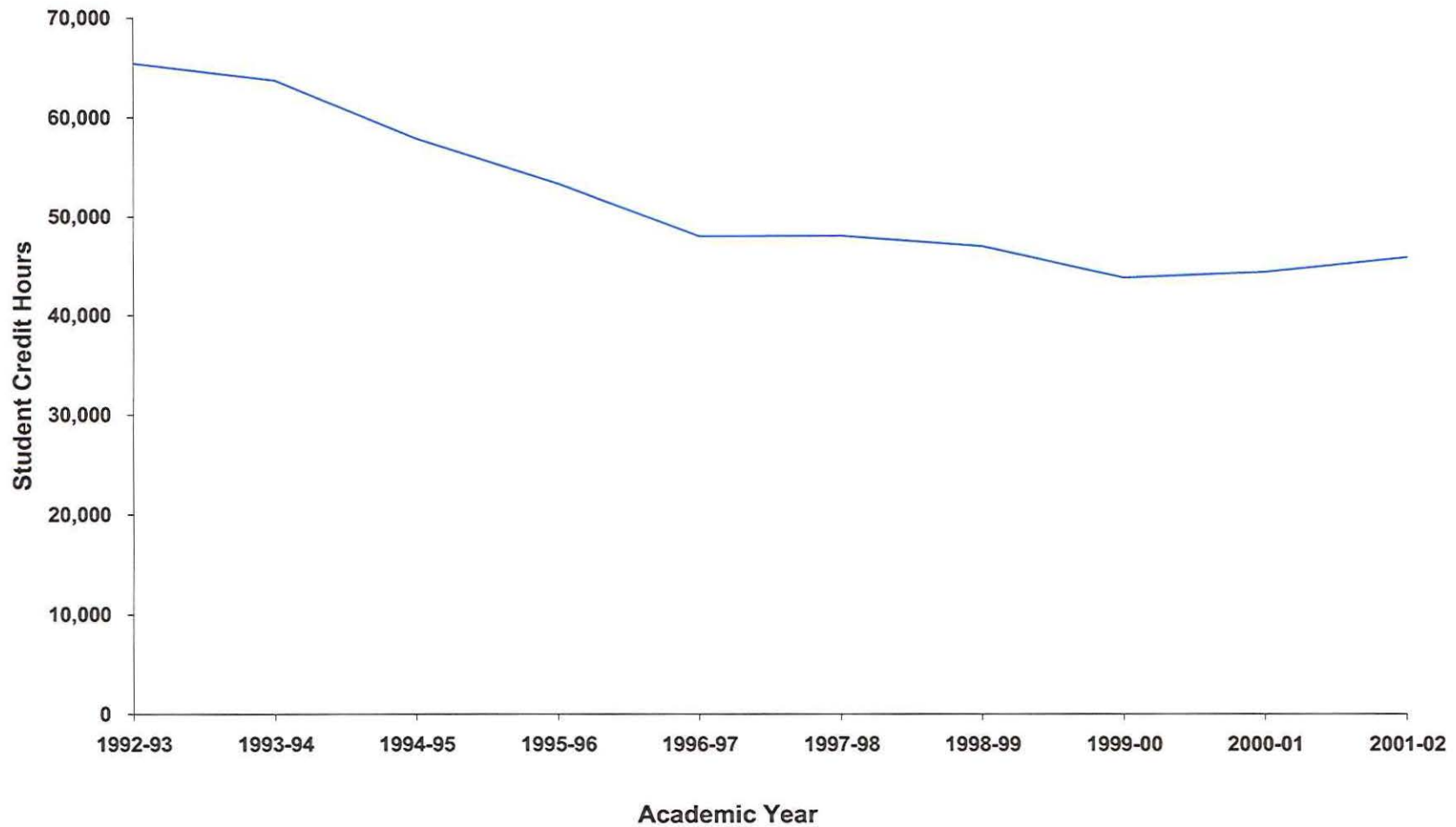
Trends over a specified period of time are illustrated by the following graphs for English.

- Ten year trend in annual credit hours generated Collegewide.

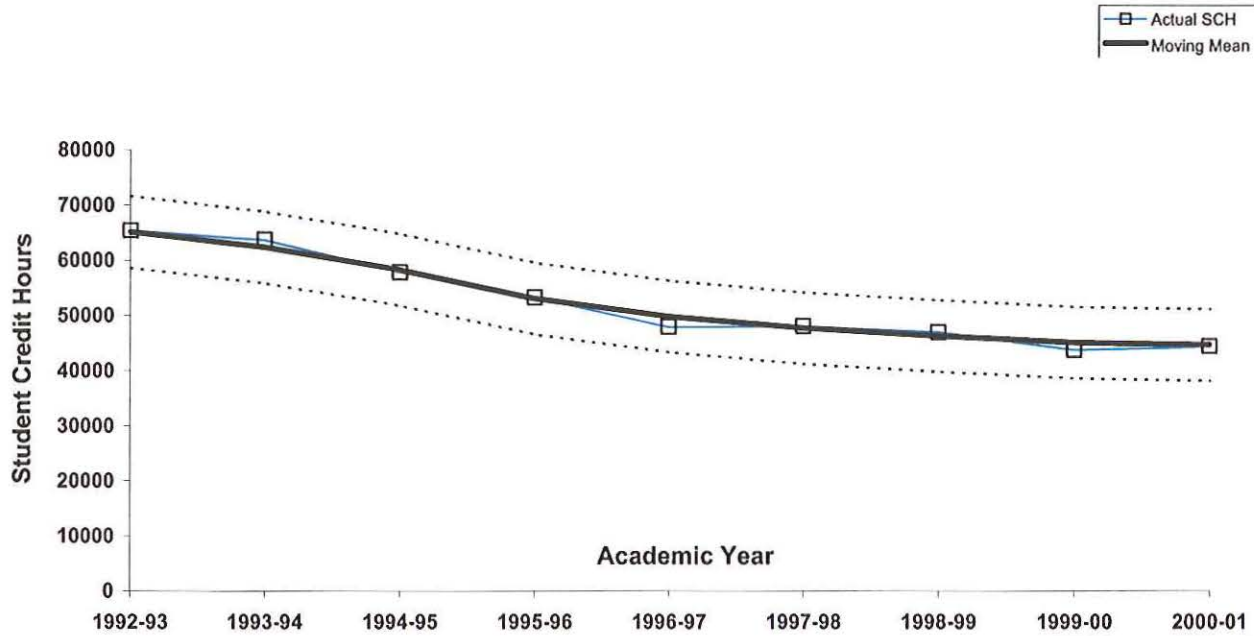

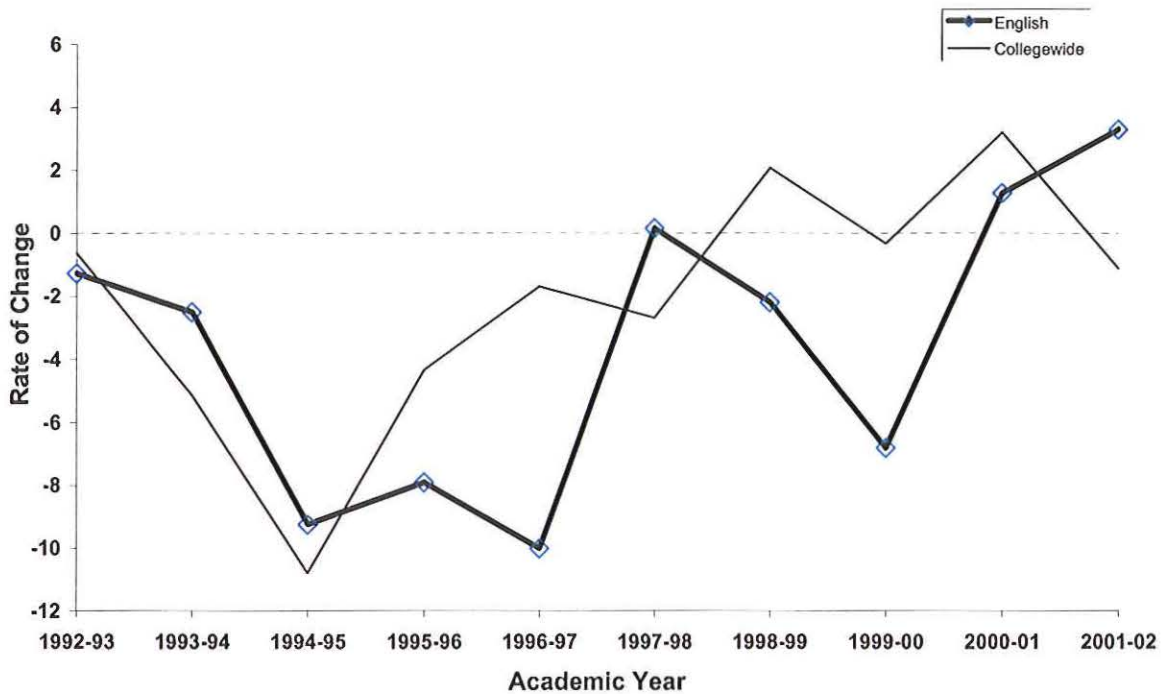

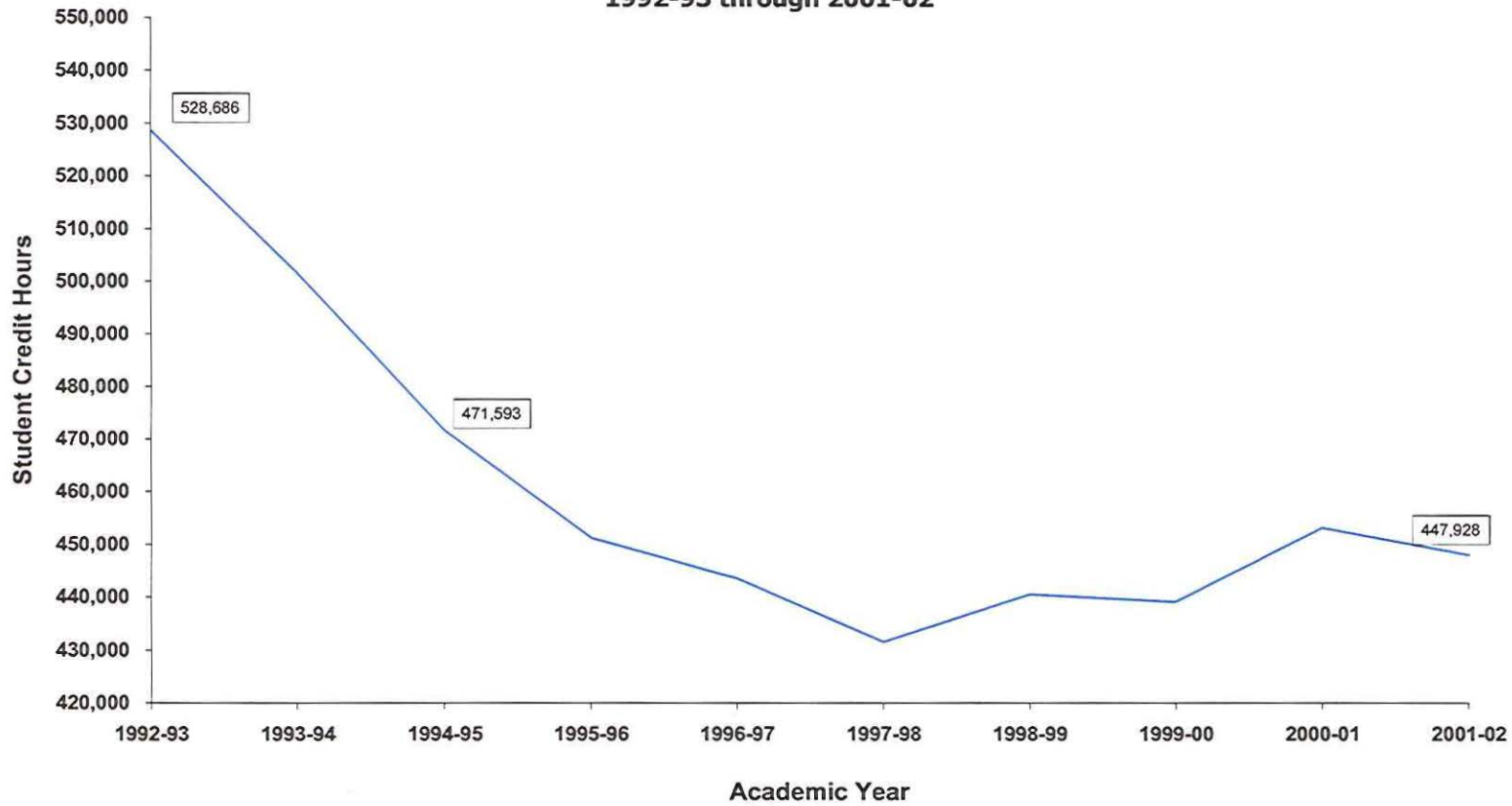
