• The Academic Senate Chair provided a summary of Senate's work during the past 2014-15 academic year and activities for next year.

## **Chancellor's Report**

- The Chancellor shared a number of updates including:
  - OCC participated in the Governor's budget press conference which included the announcement of another \$15.6 million for skilled trades programs for community colleges.
  - The 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary TV commercials featuring Brooks Patterson, Paul W. Smith and Florine Mark are gaining a lot of attention for the College.
  - The employee 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary party drew approximately 200 attendees; and on the same evening, the Great Lakes Tasting event celebrated its 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
  - Commencement featured the Honorable Justice Steven Rhodes with over 800 graduates participating.
  - The Garden Party was held and proceeds from the event benefit the OCC Culinary Studies Institute. Last year, Culinary received \$55,000 from the event.
  - o *Crain's* "Twenty in Their 20s" recognized current OCC employee Kelly Perez-Vergara and alum Niles Heron.
  - The Waterford Kettering High School "college board" showed an overwhelming majority of seniors plan to attend OCC next fall.
- Executive Director of Institutional Effectiveness Martin Orlowski and Director of Academic Effectiveness Kelly Perez-Vergara presented a summary of enrollment trends over the past decades. They noted several factors impacting enrollment:
  - Unemployment and other economic factors affect enrollment.
  - Since fall 2008, the majority of community colleges in Southeast Michigan have experienced similar enrollment cycles as OCC.
  - OCC headcount is up 6% from the pre-recession period of 2005-06 to 2013-14.
  - K-12 enrollment in Oakland County is dropping significantly.
  - Since 1960, 27 post-secondary higher education institutions (not including online schools) were established in Oakland County and this competition will increase.
