College Academic Master Plan Committee Discussion Items

Senate Leadership has suggested that the following tasks be the focus of attention for the College Academic Master Plan Committee for the 2008-2009 academic year:

- Monitor the implementation process. The committee believes one way to accomplish this task is to ask each campus for regular progress reports indicating achievement of their master plan goals.
- Encourage each campus to move to the action plan stage of the implementation process. One component of this task is to facilitate the standardization of the action plan process itself.
- Assess the past planning process and develop recommendations for the next generation of planning.

The committee is seeking verification of these tasks as formal charges from the College Academic Senate.

The committee would like to remind the senate that the original mission of the committee contained the following statement:

"The College Academic Master Plan drives curriculum development, guides resource allocation...."

The committee encourages the senate and all members of the college to consider ways in which this statement may be fulfilled.
