Flint Brethren Meet Viet Call

FLINT, Mich. — The congregation that meets at Lennon Road in Flint has met the call of Vietnam.

Maurice Hall spoke for the class session and worship period on Sunday, Nov. 28, 1965. The response that very morning to take care of orphan children was very good. The elders could not stop there, so they had a meeting to discuss the possibility of sending a missionary to Vietnam fully supported by Lennon Road.

They wanted to do this but did not know how the congregation felt about it. So the following Lord's day the challenge was presented to the congregation and they responded by

pledging \$260 per month to send a missionary to Vietnam.

The elders knew of Wayne Briggs and that Hall was trying to get some congregation to send him, so the elders had a meeting with Wayne and the decision was made that Lennon Road would send him.

Briggs is presently teaching school in the Walled Lake area. He will finish his year there and then make preparations to go to Vietnam by September of this year. Briggs will teach school in Vietnam as well as be an aid to the mission work in Saigon. He will be working with the Lennon Road congregation on some weekends to get better acquainted with the congregation and they with him.
