o Chancellor response:
While the data is not absolute and analysis is not perfect, it still represents information regarding the interests of improving our work with students and their success. Furthermore, considering the nationally recognized source of the survey, I feel it would be reasonably futile to contest the results simply because they do not point in the preferred direction. I would suggest we embrace the CCSSE survey results, discuss how we may improve those metrics/analysis of question, and follow through with action. If the results improve, then we know the survey is valid and our actions are effective.

I do hold in suspect some of the analytical techniques and experimental design considerations. Notwithstanding, there are trends for inspection and consideration related to student success. We can debate the technical aspects and look how to measure and evaluate things better. My point is this: in the meantime, the data points to perspective areas of improvement. Let's put into play strategies to address those areas and see if the needle moves. Then, the only question is how much effort is spent in these improvements.
