CONTRACTING OPTIONS

OPTION I:

DALNET signs a contract with the WSU CSC for facilities management. The WSU Library would have a separate agreement with the WSU CSC. DALNET provides all services needed by its members that the WSU CSC does not provide, via another contract with the WSU Library to function as the host institution. DALNET members contract individually with DALNET, except for the WSU Library. DALNET contracts directly with peripheral vendors for quantity prices. DALNET seeks grant monies, which it will receive and administer.

OPTION II:

DALNET signs a contract with WSU Library for services. The WSU Library has an agreement with the WSU CSC. DALNET members contract individually with DALNET, except for the WSU Library. DALNET contracts directly with peripheral vendors for quantity prices. DALNET seeks grant monies, which it will receive and administer.

OPTION III:

DALNET members sign individual contracts with the WSU Library. The contract language is negotiated by DALNET on behalf of its members. The WSU Library has an agreement with the WSU CSC for facilities management. The WSU Library, as a service bureau, contracts with peripheral vendors for quantity prices. The WSU Library seeks grant monies on behalf of DALNET, and receives and administers the funds as advised by DALNET.

OPTION IV:

A combination of previous options.

DALNET Governance Structure:

If DALNET needs to enter into contracts, receive funds, and own property, it probably should be a corporation.

If DALNET does not need to enter into contracts, etc., it could be a membership organization.
