Grades of C or higher were more frequent when students enrolled in exempt courses (48.6% ENG 1055 and 59.1% ENG 1060)

Conversly, Grades below C were more frequent when students enrolled in Non-Exempt courses (58.0% ENG 1055 and 51.3% ENG 1060)
