

Report from Online Prioritization Ad Hoc Committee

Our "charge":

- ❖ Task 1: Create a set of criteria for selecting the first degree or program for the college to offer online.
- ❖ Task 2: Create a set of criteria for selecting the order in which programs will be placed online.
- ❖ Task 3: Create a set of criteria for determining the order in which faculty take online training.

TASK 1: The list below is the criteria we propose for selecting the first degree or program for OCC to offer online.

- ❖ The Instructor(s) for this program have already been trained.
- ❖ The Instructor(s) have experience in teaching online.
- ❖ The classes in this program been offered online before.
- ❖ There is NO required face-to-face lab or practical anywhere in the program.
- ❖ The Instructors for this program are online-ready.
- ❖ There is a guided-pathway for the program to be offered sequentially.
- ❖ The certificate or certificate of achievement be used to build towards a degree.
- ❖ There is support for the student in that program (i.e. tutoring, library, bookstore, technical support)
- ❖ There has been purposeful discussion within the Discipline of offering this program online.
- ❖ This program has the Discipline approval to be offered online.
- ❖ This program is transferable to other institutions.
- ❖ This program does have/meet/need external agency compliance. (ie federal government, state government)
- ❖ The number of classes the program has. (Least amount for quicker completion for the HLC application)

RECOMMENDATION: The Committee recommends the **Homeland Security Level 1 Certificate of Achievement (HLS.LV1.CA)** as OCC's first program to be offered online. There are 6 courses in the program, with Discipline purposeful discussion and approval. There is a guided-pathway for the Student to finish in 2 semesters. The program is transferable and has

external compliance. Ken Van Sparrentak is in the first training group and online ready.

- ❖ Has taught online at other institutions.
- ❖ The course is on the General education list

MOTION: To offer as many training classes as possible in the Winter 2016, so that faculty can teach hybrid classes in Summer 2016, and that the training is online **(PASSED)**

MOTION: OCC will have enough trainings so that all faculty who have been teaching online will have access to training by the end of Summer, 2016 **(PASSED)**
