

Preparations for new four-year business program continue

Preparations for offering of the Bachelor of Business Administration degree by Michigan Christian College continued actively throughout the past summer. Significant progress in the library and with the self-study process, as well as an addition to the faculty, brought MCC a little closer to the new four-year program.

During the summer, library workers completed the major task of changing the entire business collection to the Library of Congress classification system. In addition, the library accessioned over 210 new business volumes, most of which were reference works. The additions completed the reference section recommended by a library consultant as those works needed to support the B.B.A. degree. Over 300 additional business titles will be accessioned in coming months.

Months of research and writing also drew to a close by late summer as a self-study document for the Michigan Department of Education received final revisions. This document, which reviews MCC's plans and ability to offer the B.B.A. degree, will trigger a visit by a state examining team during the winter. The document then will be formatted for the North Central Association. An NCA evaluation team is scheduled to review the B.B.A. program as a

part of their reaccreditation visit on March 13-15, 1989.

As classes began, Katheryn Wilkins joined the faculty as an Assistant Professor of Business. Mrs. Wilkins brings with her a wealth of practical experience in the business world in addition to her academic training. For seven years, she operated Business Management Services, in which she provided research, personnel, and accounting services to small businesses. Most recently, she completed numerous assignments for Ford Motor Company in their overseas purchasing division.

The new business program is being designed to provide students with practical, realistic experiences. In many classes, students "start their own company" and relate the topics of the class to that business. The ideal suburban location of MCC provides unlimited opportunities for field trips and visiting speakers who can share their experiences in the business world.

While MCC has been preparing for the B.B.A. program, students have been able to pursue an extended business program at MCC through their junior year of college. This program was designed for students to complete a Bachelor's degree with approximately one year of additional work in another college or university.
