



Since the total number of students attending OCC from Livingston County over the past five years is a relatively small number (2,213), we can assume that the number taking online courses is also small. A cursory review of online students (taken from an Online Student Survey conducted in Winter 2002) shows none of the survey respondents (N=181) were from Livingston County. A more in-depth analysis of on-line student residency could be conducted given additional time.
