New eLibrary Collection: TED Videos



Jing Jing Wu, DALNET practicum student, has finished her summer projects in the office. Along with helping to configure and launch "Get (t Local)", Jing Jing created a new TED Collection for the DALNET eLibrary. The popular TED Talks video series offers "Great talks to stir your curiosity." Jing Jing used tools to mine metadata from the <u>TED com</u> website and adding this information to a spreadsheet for TED videos. She then used free <u>MarcEdt</u> software to convert the spreadsheet to MARC records. The cataloged videos are now part of the DALNET union catalog and are also available to others for loading in their catalogs. Ultimately the collection will be added to the OCLC Digital Collection Gateway for access by libraries world-wide.
