Fall 1995 Enrollment Trends Report

Date:

October 9, 1995

As of the official count date for the Fall 1995 term, enrollment has declined 3.6% from Fall 1994 totals. Furthermore, enrollment has decreased 10% over the last five years and 3% over the past ten years. Detailed information concerning these and other trends and illustrated in the attached Fall 1995 Enrollment Trends Report. A brief summary of this report includes:

- The average age of an OCC student is 28 years old. Data continues to show that, on average, female students are approximately three years older than male students.
- Highland Lakes and Royal Oak/Southfield have the largest proportion of female students.
- The percentage of minority students has increased from 14% in Fall 1991 to 19% in Fall 1995 (college-wide).
- In Fall 1995, 80% of students are enrolled part-time. The ratio between full-time and part-time students has remained steady over the past five years. Furthermore, nearly two-thirds (60%) of part-time students are female.
- When comparing Fall, Winter, Spring and Summer enrollments, the proportion of part-time female and full-time male enrollment remains consistent. Part-time male enrollment declines in the Spring term.
- The average number of seats per section and student credit hours per section, is highest in the Fall term than in all other terms.










Trends in College-Wide Mean Age by Gender








College-Wide Trends in Student Ethnicity (Fall 1991 Through Fall 1995)











College-Wide Trends in Student Return Rate (Fall 1992 Through Fall 1995)








Oakland Community College Trends in Sections, SCH & Section Size by Campus (Fall 1991 Through Fall 1995)






Trends in Number of Sections




Trends in Total Seats





Trends in Average Seats per Section




Trends in Average Student Credit Hours per Section




Term Comparison of Student Gender (Winter 1995 Through Fall 1995)




Term Comparison of Student Ethnicity (Winter 1995 Through Fall 1995)



Term Comparison of Full/Part Time Status (Winter 1995 Through Fall 1995)





Term Comparison of Student Residency Status (Winter 1995 Through Fall 1995)




Term Comparison of Student Age* (Winter 1995 Through Fall 1995)

Graph 1. Student Mean Age










Term Comparison of Student Age (Winter 1995 Through Fall 1995)


Graph 1. Student Age for Winter 1995




Graph 2. Student Age for Spring 1995



Graph 3. Student Age for Summer 1995




Graph 4. Student Age for Fall 1995




Term Comparison of Student Return Rate (Winter 1995 Through Fall 1995)

Graph 1. Student Return Rate by Gender




Graph 2. Student Return Rate by Ethnicity




Term Comparison of Average Seats and SCH per Section (Winter 1995 Through Fall 1995)












Graph 1. Student Ethnicity by Percent



College-Wide Trends in Student Full/Part-Time Status (Spring 1992 Through Spring 1995)


















Term Comparison of Student Gender (Summer 1994 Through Spring 1995)




Term Comparison of Student Ethnicity (Summer 1994 Through Spring 1995)





Term Comparison of Student Residency Status (Summer 1994 Through Spring 1995)




Term Comparison of Student Age* (Summer 1994 Through Spring 1995)






Student Age for Fall 1995




