As of the official count date, fall term enrollment has decreased $5.7 \%$ over the last ten years and declined $15.1 \%$ over the past five years. Detailed information depicting these and student demographic trends are illustrated in the attached Fall 1996 Enrollment Trends Report. Highlights from this report include:

- The average age of fall terms students is 28 . On average, female students are two years older than male students. Over the past ten years, the majority of fall term students have been between the ages of 19 and 20 .
- Highland Lakes and Royal Oak/Southfield have the largest proportion of female students, while Orchard Ridge and Royal Oak/Southfield have approximately $10 \%$ more out of district students than do the Auburn Hills and Highland Lakes.
- The percent of minority students continues to grow. Over the past five years minority enrollment has increased from $15 \%$ (fall 1992) to $21 \%$ in fall 1996 (college-wide).
- In fall 1996, $80 \%$ of students are enrolled part-time. The proportion of part-time students has remained steady over the past five years. Furthermore, approximately two-thirds $(62 \%)$ of part-time students are female.
- Student return rate (summer to fall ) has dropped slightly from $39 \%$ in fall 1992 to $34 \%$ in fall 1996.
