#### Oakland Community College High School Dual Enrollment – Huron Valley School District Fall 2001 and Winter 2002

This report provides the number of high school dual enrollment students and high school guest students from the Huron Valley School district – Lakeland High School and Milford High School. It is based upon official (One-Tenth Day) data for the Fall 2001 and Winter 2002 terms.

*High school guests* are OCC students who are currently enrolled in high school, are under the age of 18, and whose high school class has not graduated. Students are responsible for all tuition, books, and course fees.

*High school dual enrollment students* are high school guest students who take OCC courses (that are not currently offered by the high school district) for college and high school credit. The high school district is responsible for tuition and course fees.

During the Fall 2001 term, the Huron Valley District had 23 dual enrollment students at OCC, all from Lakeland High School. In Winter 2002, there were 26 dual enrollment students – 20 from Lakeland High School and 6 from Milford High School.
