Executive Summary

Students of Oakland Community College (OCC) who have not registered for classes in four consecutive semesters and who have not earned a degree or certificate are polled to determine the major reasons for not returning. Survey questions cover various subjects, including reasons for not returning to OCC, employment status, and educational goals. Those students who transferred to other schools were asked about their satisfaction with transfer procedures and academic preparation here at ECC.

For 2009, 524 non-returning students were surveyed. Their results are indicated as follows:

- Over fifty-six percent (56.5%) of respondents (n=46) stated that their major reason for not returning to OCC was 'decided to transfer to another college or university.'
 Originally, 35.6% of respondents (n=236) stated their educational goal was 'to complete courses to transfer to another institution WITHOUT obtaining an OCC degree or certificate.'
- One-third (33.2%) of respondents (n=173) stated that they were attending another (17a) college or university. Oakland University (n=35) was the most reported current school attended.
- Almost ninety percent (87.4%) stated that they were satisfied with the number of credits accepted by other colleges or universities when transferring.
- Almost sixty percent (58.2%) stated that their program of study at OCC was not garrelated to their employment.
- When asked if they would return to OCC, over fifty-seven percent (57.4%) of non-gc returning students (n=235) responded they 'definitely would return.'





- Over eighty-seven percent (87.2%) of respondents (n=172) stated satisfaction in reference to the number of OCC credits that were accepted at their most recent school.



· 'Somewhat satisfied' and 'very satisfied' were combined to measure satisfaction.







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
Chart 6: Employment Relation to OCC Program


Chart 7: Skills Learned at OCC




