## Basic Terminology

- Headcount: Number of students enrolled at any given point in time.
(Duplicated Versus Unduplicated)


## Basic Terminology

- Credit Hour: One credit hour is equal to 800 instructional minutes.


## Basic Terminology

■ First-time Student: Student who has never enrolled at OCC in the past.

## Basic Terminology

■ First-Time In Any College (FTIAC): New student who has never attended any post-secondary institution.

## Basic Terminology

- Academic Year: July 1 through June 30. Also, coincides with the College's fiscal year.


## Basic Terminology

■ One Tenth Day of Term (1/10 Day): Official count (census) date for counting enrollment. Calculated by adding the total number of days between the first and last day of a term (including weekends \& holidays) then dividing by 10.

## Basic Terminology

- Section One Tenth Day: An individual section's official count (census) date.
Calculated by adding the total number of days between the sections first day and last day then dividing by 10.
