

# **Events and Projects**

## **Annual Meeting**

The first ever DALNET Annual membership meeting was held at the University of Detroit Mercy. Over 70 staff members from 15 DALNET libraries attended the event. UDM sponsored the morning session as planned by the Libraries/IDS Employee Development Committee chaired by Sally Young. Warren Graham, author of Black Belt Librarian, was guest speaker. An overview of DALNET planning and projects was given and attendees had the opportunity to attend discussion sessions.

#### Grants

The DALNET Board approved grant funding to establish a DALNET Digital Archive Repository to create access to new online collections for participating members Adam Cardinal Maida Alumni Library, Detroit Medical Center, Marygrove College, and Oakland Community College. The project has begun and it is anticipated that other members will join the repository at a later date. This year the Board also continued to offer participating members reimbursement for state-wide delivery services, funded through the DALNET grant program, to foster resource sharing for our member libraries.

# Looking Ahead

The DALNET Board approved funding for two important projects to strengthen DALNET support of member libraries. In addition to approving work for installation of a new discovery catalog in the forthcoming year, the Board approved establishment of new ERM (Electronic Resource Management) services to include a link resolver and electronic resource A - Z list for member libraries. Both new projects are intended to strengthen support for access to electronic resources at member libraries, and the discovery catalog will include records from the DALNET Digital Repository.

# Resource Sharing Expanded

DALNET expanded the benefits of consortium membership by enabling reciprocal borrowing among participating libraries. Patrons have expanded access to member library resources through their home library catalogs using the DALNET shared system. The BookMyne mobile catalog app was also implemented this year to offer patrons another way to search the DALNET shared system for DALNET Get It Local! items to borrow.



## DALNET eLibrary 5000 Open Access eResources

The expanded and rebranded DALNET eLibrary now contains 19 distinct collections offering eBooks, eJournals, Videos, Podcasts, and Websites. Accessible through all member library catalogs, and online at: elibrary.dalnet.org



# TED Talks Videos Added to DALNET eLibrary

The popular TED Talks video series was added to the DALNET eLibrary and member catalogs. This addition of over 1,000 titles was made possible through the summer work project of DALNET practicum student Jing Jing Wu, a graduate of the Wayne State University School of Library and Information Science. Ms. Wu has been hired temporarily as a Special Projects Librarian for DALNET.
