Discovery Layer Interfaces (Single Search Catalogs)

Components of Discovery Interfaces

- **Single search** via compiled indexing, for integrated search of print and electronic resources, and institutional repositories
- Full-text searching of **article level resources** from databases
- **Link resolver**, built in, or working in conjunction with
- A major, **additional cost**, to the library system. Eventually we may see discovery interface costs bundled within the offerings of the new library automation platforms.
- **Next-Generation OPACs**: Relevancy ranking, spell checking and search suggestion, tagging, rating, reviews, faceted searching, RSS, SMS (text-messaging), enriched content

Implications for DALNET

- DALNET has hoped for years to adopt a **single search platform** but has never budgeted or planned for such a move.
- DALNET members are **discontented with our traditional**, aging OPAC.
- Next-generation OPACs**, although not complete discovery tools, are still more advanced than our traditional OPAC.
- Next-generation OPACs and advanced Discovery Layers can be **implemented independently** from an integrated library system.
- DALNET may plan to adopt** a major discovery platform simultaneous to a major system migration. An economical next-generation OPAC product may also provide some change for the interim.

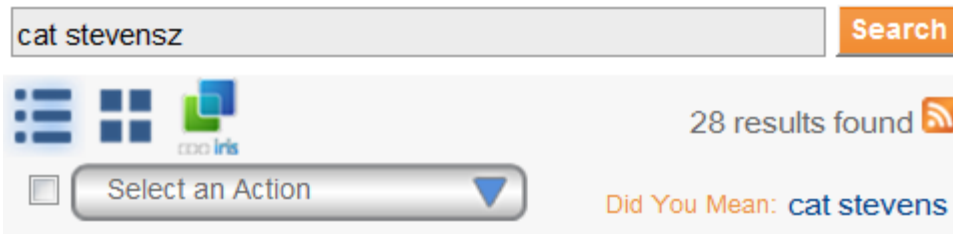

Library Automation Platforms (The New Library Systems)

What Is A Platform?



- A computing platform includes some sort of **hardware architecture and a software framework** (including application frameworks), where the combination allows software, particularly application software, to run.

- Cloud Computing: hosted technological infrastructure with no local installation, accessed via a Web browser



- Open Systems with Web APIs



Components of Library Platforms

- **Cloud computing:** hosted technological infrastructure with no local installation, accessed via a Web browser
- A **single system** for management of all library resources
- **Greater cooperation and shared data** among institutions
- **Combined workflows**, including digital asset management
- **Focus on fulfillment**, patron driven
- New and **open systems** with Web APIs
- **Scalability:** for small, large, and groups

Implications for DALNET

- DALNET has **waited to migrate** to a new system until there was a discernible difference in possible systems to adopt.
- Adoption of a library system platform would completely change the **technological infrastructure** of DALNET, i.e. greatly reduce the number of servers and their costs for maintenance.
- A new platform has the potential to allow DALNET members to **redesign workflows** for acquisition and processing of print and electronic resources, with more time to provide library services.
- DALNET would be able to **focus on services** instead of spending the bulk of time on running the system.
- Migration to a new system will necessitate a complete review and **shift in focus for DALNET annual operating costs**.





- RFP (Request for Proposals) process
- Reviewing the market and hosting product demonstrations
