## **Chancellor's Cabinet (CC)**

The CC meets one day each month to discuss *strategic* issues and 1/2-day each month to coordinate *operational* issues.

#### **October 2005 Strategic Meeting Topics**

- 1. October Board of Trustees (BOT) agenda: Prepare the draft for the BOT's Executive Officers to review, finalize and distribute the agenda according to BOT policy and the Open Meetings Act.

  Leaders: entire CC
- 2006 Federal Earmarks: Discuss possible ideas regarding the submission of white papers for the 2006 federal appropriation funding cycle. More discussion will follow to narrow the topics to 5 or 6 that the lobbyists will review. Final requests must be completed in January to begin the process. Projects should connect to the college's strategic planning objectives. Leaders: C. Kozell and M. Spangler
- 3. Exploring E-Learning Reforms in Michigan: Handout and brief discussion of concept of requiring high school students to complete one college course online before graduation. Leader: M. Spangler
- 4. Faculty Staffing Input Committee: Report on the subcommittee's recommendations, including faculty attending Vacancy Committee meetings and observing discussions. **Leader:** G. May
- Position Statement on Students' Observance of Major Religious Holidays: Discussion of proposed language and next steps in the process of informing the college about the CC position. Leader: G. Keith
- 6. Student Ambassador Program: Update on applicants responding (10) and next steps in rolling out activities, including attending OR culinary dinner and theater program, Detroit Economic Club speech by U of M president, Automation Alley lecture series and Superhighway event, and Oakland Schools Community Forum. Plans also shared regarding a training session to engage students. Leaders: G. Keith & M. Spangler

#### October 2005 Operational Meeting Topics

- Information materials: Distributed documents on MI Colleges Reporting Faulty Data to State, IPEDS Data Feedback Report 2005, and OCC Hurricane Katrina Relief Efforts summary report. Updated on MCCA Board of Directors meeting regarding position on funding formula and task forces on performance indicators proposed for 2006-07 state budget. Identified opportunities for OCC faculty and staff to participate in ETS research activities with request the information be forwarded as quickly as possible. Leader: M. Spangler
- 2. DO Space Planning: Discussed BOT request (10/17/05) for Special Session on 11/7/05, including preparing documents on staffing and department functions, previous space planning study, and possible recommendations from CC. Leader: M. Spangler
- 3. *Continuing Action Plan:* Reviewed activities from previous months to update the status and ensure completion of those activities. Changes to be forwarded for compilation. **Leader:** G. Keith for M. Spangler
- 4. Library Strategic Plan: Lodged for endorsement at next operational meeting along with responding to request for names of "plan creators" identified in the plan. **Leader:** G. Keith
- 5. Higher Learning Commission Visit Update: Discussion on HLC information with regard to presenting it with staff, holding March 16-19, 2008, as potential focus visit timeframe, reviewing steering membership and forwarding changes to Accreditation Liaison Officer, and hearing an update report quarterly at CC. Leader: G. Keith with C. Maze and M. McGee
