### DALNET BOARD MINUTES

### June 9, 1994 Oakland Community College, Royal Oak Campus

The Meeting was called to order by S. Frankie, Chair, at 10:10 a.m. at Oakland Community College, Royal Oak Campus. She announced that Dick Beer would be able to join the members during lunch to receive his awards of appreciation for service to DALNET as a member of the Board.

1.0 MINUTES - M. Auer moved and F. Young seconded approval of the minutes as distributed.

ACTION: minutes approved as distributed.

2.0 MDAS PRICE PROPOSAL: L. Bugg distributed copies of the allocation of database costs and Current Contents Usage reports. R. Harris explained the methodology for distributing the costs among the DALNET libraries. The Board was asked to approve the methodology and costs. Board members discussed the proposed allocation of subscription fees; asking for clarification of certain areas including the source of the figures quoted. WSU staff would like to be able to consolidate negotiations for databases. They asked for a commitment of a maximum dollar amount figure from each member which they could use in negotiations.

ACTION: DALNET members are to notify R. Harris of which databases they wish by July 7, 1994. The databases to be considered are: Current Contents, Wilson, ERIC, and CINAHL. Members are also required to indicate the maximum dollar amount they are willing to pay.

ACTION: R. Harris will revise the Allocation of Database Costs chart based upon the July responses.

ACTION: Members will advise L. Bugg of any additional databases WSU should investigate for MDAS or include in negotiations.

ACTION: L. Bugg and R. Harris were commended for their work in obtaining MDAS databases and contract negotiations.

- 3.0 CENTRAL SITE: L. Bugg reported that upgrades to system controller and CPU capacity with installation of CACHE memory and the IBM 9221 will improve system performance by approximately 80%. The new CPU will be installed June 25, 1994 and June 26, 1994. System staff projects no major interruptions in service. However, they are allowing about seven days to fine tune the CPU. They estimate that this upgrade will be sufficient for at least two years.
- 4.0 MRLT PACLink: L. Bugg distributed copies of minutes from the DALNET Access Task Force (DATF). The Board discussed the impact of the Michigan Research Libraries Triangle project, the appearance of LCAT (MSU) and MCAT (U of M) in DALNET's system, and implementation of PACLink and PACLoan. Board members also discussed the major issues and Task Force recommendations.

ACTION: ITEM 1 - Should the display of LCAT/MCAT be optional on an institution by institution basis? DATF Recommendation, yes. The DALNET Board voted agreement with the recommendation. LCAT/MCAT display will be an institution option.

**ACTION:** ITEM 2 - Should existing institution ILL policies/procedures be kept in tact? DATF Recommendation, yes. The Board agreed that it was inappropriate to take action on the question, which must be addressed by each institution individually.

**ACTION:** ITEM 3 - Should the Access Directory be distributed to U of M and MSU? DATF Recommendation, yes. The DALNET Board approved distribution. The Access Directory will be distributed to U of M and MSU.

**ACTION:** ITEM 4 - Should ILL statistics be re-compiled for U of M Dearborn and U of M Flint? DATF Recommendation, yes. The Board approved re-compiling the statistics.

**ACTION:** ITEM 5 - Should signs be developed to publicize PACLink? DATF Recommendation, yes. The Board approved development of new signs. WSU agreed to distribute signs that they have developed.

ACTION: ITEM 6 - Should other statistics by kept to evaluate the increase of use of our collection as a result of PACLink? DATF Recommendation, yes. The Board voted approval. Statistics will be kept to evaluate collection use resulting from PACLink installation.

planning for future systems: L. Bugg reported activities and planning sessions held by WSU Systems Office staff and DALNET project managers to discuss the future of NOTIS, what will be the system requirements, and what institutions need to do to prepare. She reviewed the major issues and options for the Board. The Board also discussed Internet access as a key component of system upgrade. Questions concerning current Michnet membership, and DALNET institutions options were addressed.

ACTION: The Board approved use of the DALNET name in negotiating with MICHNET.

**ACTION:** L. Bugg will answer the following: how will the addition of non-MICHNET libraries affect current DALNET/MICHNET members?

6.0 BORROWING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN WSU AND DALNET LIBRARIES: WSU staff proposed a prepayment option for DALNET libraries. ILLs from WSU will cost \$5.00 per transaction with a deposit account of \$1,000 (minimum).

**ACTION:** Members should inform R. Harris if they are interested in opening an ILL deposit account.

6.1 WSU/OAKLAND PROJECT: L. Bugg provided the Board with an update of the WSU and Oakland University pilot project which gives students guest borrowing privileges. The universities are evaluating the success of the project including costs. No additional DALNET institutions will be asked to participate at this time.

6.2 U of M SERVICE TICKETS: L. Bugg described a "service ticket" program in place at U of M in which the University subsidizes a portion of those ILLs which are requested in support of research. She asked if the Board was interested in investigating a similar program.

ACTION: Board members were very interested in the Service Ticket program and requested further investigation for DALNET.

### 7.0 REPORTS:

- 7.1 FIRST SEARCH: L. Bugg reported group rates for OCLCs First Search and asked if DALNET would be interested. There was no interest in pursuing a group option.
- 7.2 DALNET NEW MEMBERS: WSU has no additional requests for membership. The DIA contract, however, has been signed.
- 7.3 WSU SEARCH FOR DEAN OF LIBRARIES: P. Spyers-Duran described activities surrounding the announcement of his retirement. He has agreed to stay on through November/December until the University has found his replacement. He briefly described the interview process and invited the DALNET Board to participate and meet with the final candidates during the second round of interviews. S. Frankie thanked him for the offer. P. Spyers-Duran will send the schedule to the Board as soon as it is available.
- 8.0 NEXT MEETING: The next meeting of the Board was scheduled for Thursday, October 13, 1994 at Oakland University.

### 9.0 ANNOUNCEMENTS

J. Curtis announced that McGregor Library, Highland Park, will be added to DALNET in conjunction with DPL holdings.

LIBRARY PRACTICES: M. Auer polled the Board about their ideas and practice in a situation in which a library finds a patron has a book from another library which has not been charged out. She specifically wanted to know if institutions kept the book and sent it back to the home library.

ACTION: The question will be forwarded to the DALNET Circulation Committee for discussion and recommendations. Members also discussed general practice of suspending borrowing privileges for those clients with large fines at other DALNET libraries.

The meeting adjourned at 12:12 p.m.

### MDAS Licenses for DALNET Libraries October 1994

### 1. Wilson

Wilson requires one-time payment for those libraries using data prior to January 1989. They are willing to accept payment for these costs over 3 years.

Currently, the Wilson database is a single file from 1982/83 to date. The only way to enable libraries to opt out of the backfile payment is to split the database into two segments, which involves more system resources.

ACTION REQUESTED: Decision as to which libraries will license Wilson.

#### 2. ERIC

Costs have been allocated to those DALNET libraries interested in ERIC.

ACTION REQUESTED: Decision to proceed.

#### 3. Cinahl

Costs have been allocated to those DALNET libraries interested in ERIC.

ACTION REQUESTED: Decision to proceed.

### 4. Current Contents

Oakland University has licensed this database. No other DALNET libraries are participating at this time.
