Building Landmark For Iron Mountain Bought Recently

IRON MOUNTAIN, Mich. — The very few members of the Iron Mountain Church of Christ have taken the first major step in more firmly establishing the Lord's church here. They purchased on July 16 the former Baptist church building and preachers home. It cost them \$8,000.

The building is located one block from the main street and near the center of the business section. The purchase of this property was made possible with the help of the Meadowbrook Church of Christ in Fort Worth, Tex.

The church building is of brick construction and is in very good condition. It will seat about 200 people, and has a baptistry. The preacher's home is in good repair and is ready when a full-time evangelist is secured.

Iron Mountain is strictly a mission area and this effort will need the backing of the brethren from other areas if it is to move forward.

The next major step will be to find a full time evangelist family to move there with full support to take the lead in the work. It would be a great help to have members with leadership abilities to move there, find secular work and help in this great effort.
