11 Mile West of Lahser

Presently meeting in rented quarters at 24180 10½ Mile Road (Franklin Road) near Berg, the Church of Christ in Southfield will begin meetings in their new building Sunday, December 6, 1964.

The church had its beginning October 7, 1956. The meeting place was the Brooks School (pictured above in its present use as a library). The first part of the school was built in 1836.

From the first the congregation began planning for a permanent church home. Property was purchased on Lahser Road near 11 Mile, but before building plans could be completed it was learned that expansion of Northwestern Highway would use part of the lot.

After later negotiation with state authorities, the church traded that land for property of equal value on 11 Mile just west of Lahser
