Mio Church of Christ

Past History of Mio Church of Christ:

In the year of 1967 Mio church was a frame house with four cabins that was past using.

This property was purchased by Walled Lake Church of Christ in 1954- to start a mission work. Walled Lake supported this mission 1967. In 1968 all the cabins were torn down and a new building was started.

The old dwelling house where services were held would seat about thirty people. In the Spring of 1968 the new building was started and in October of the same year the building was finished to the point that we could hold services in the new building.

Our new building will seat, two hundred fifty people, this building is forty feet by eighty feet

In 1972 Walled Lake could no longer support the work here so the work and property was transferred over to the congregation here legally by transferring of all the responsibility of business to the Mio congregation.

Our monthly building payment was \$365.00 per month plus all other expenses. We couldn't make the payments so we re-financed the building without getting any cash- This dropped our payments to \$270.00 per month on the building. This was still a heavy load but we managed to go forward and some growth in membership.

Through the support from the Plum Street Foundation and with some new growth we are able to pay our bills.

The Bristol Road School of Preaching has been of great help supplying us with preachers in the past two years. Also some of the churches in our own area are a help when we get in a bind.

The year 1975 we paid our preachers \$1,750.00 for their services.
