Laurium, Mich., Sept. 16.—The Disciples have rented for one year the well-located and comfortable house, owned and used on Lord's day meetings by the German Reformed people. Yesterday afternoon five more grown young people were baptized into Christ, and we hope others will follow. This copper country is a field for "foreign missions," as nearly all the languages of Europe and many of Asia are spoken by these 45,000 people. Mines and towns are scattered all over this north point of Houghton County, "Other religious bodies" are here in force, and of these are all "branches" making up the tree-or "one invisible church"--there is no need of another "branch."
