

College Academic Master Plan Committee

2010-2011 Charges

Presented to the College Academic Senate
September 23, 2010

The College Academic Master Plan Committee has identified the following areas of work for the 2010-2011 academic year:

- **Monitor college academic planning and implementation.** The committee will continue to both gather and distribute academic planning information. In particular, the committee will encourage campuses to continue or begin the process of aligning their campus plans with the college's strategic plan. The committee will adhere to the following reporting schedule:
 - Nov. 1: Campuses report to the committee the specific portions of their plans (goals, objectives, etc.) they intend to prioritize and achieve in the coming year. This report will also include changes made to their plans and new initiatives they are pursuing that are not explicitly stated in their plans. This information will be shared at the November college senate meeting and on Infomart.*
 - March 1: Campuses report to the committee current progress on achieving the priorities identified in November. This report will also include changes made to their plans and new initiatives they are pursuing that are not explicitly stated in their plans. This information will be shared at the February college senate meeting and on Infomart.*
 - June 1: Campuses submit to the committee a final report on the year's achievements. This report will also include changes made to their plans and new initiatives they are pursuing that are not explicitly stated in their plans. This information will be shared at the June college senate meeting and on Infomart.*
- **Investigate the relationships between strategic and academic planning and facilities and information technology planning.** The committee will make recommendations to the college senate after completing its investigation.

The committee is seeking verification of these tasks as formal charges from the College Academic Senate.
