OTIS GATEWOOD

Few men of the Churches of Christ had the charisma, the boldness and the zeal for the Lord as did the first President of what is now Rochester College. After a successful mission among Mormons in Salt Lake City, his sponsoring congregation, the Broadway Church of Christ in Lubbock, TX sent him to bombed-out Germany immediately after World War II. He persuaded several others to join him in a great work of benevolence, evangelism, youth work and church building in Europe. This book, Preaching in the Footsteps of Hitler, was published in 1960, was a written and pictorial record of this work. He became the founding President of North Central Christian College in 1959.
