CSC Coordinating Team Meeting
December 11, 1985

1. Applications programmer/analyst --

A candidate for the position was interviewed during the first hour of the meeting. After the interview, one new applicant was reviewed, along with the previous applicants. A recommendation was made to make a job offer. Jim Williams will handle the necessary approvals and procedures immediately, so the offer can be made before the University's "holiday" hiring freeze takes effect December 12. It is highly desirable that the applications programmer be present for the December 16 installation.

2. Preparations for NOTIS installation --

A conference call to Randy Manakes of NOTIS is scheduled for noon today.

Rick will set up a second CICS region to use during the installation. NOTIS tables with WSUL values can be stored there, leaving the NOTIS test system intact. A tape with test files of NOTIS records is expected to arrive today.

Louise will pursue getting a barcode scanner to operate on the Telex 476L, as well as a Telex 281B printer, for the installation. Barcoded books will be gathered for testing the system.

The installation is still a "go" for December 16th.

3. System software prices --

Tony had compiled a list of system software, some IBM and some other, needed for the IBM 4381 in addition to the products identified in the NOTIS draft contract.

Frank is still compiling the list of network software needed.

Kelly Dazsi will check the prices on this software with Art and have them by next week.

Tony gave a draft of the article to Jim and Louise for review by the Library.

5. Terminal installation --

Louise is working on the Telex terminal order.

Jerry gave Louise the terminal installation schedule and offered to help with tasks needing immediate attention.
