Shared authority file – outstanding issue – no date assigned from ALS No letter of agreement about image module

Three priorities:

Children's OPAC RSS link to Docline Booking module

Monthly status reports from ALS on the status

Changes to Docline mentioned

Beta site for media scheduling due Q2 19999

Broadcast searching for staff only works in RSS

Pharos has WebPAC 1.3 and RSS running

DPL needs WebPAC 1.3 for handling large number of copies

Set up a list of FAQ's

Need for training and test databases up early enough, Need it about two months in advance before production database is created.

Lack of wiring in some sites

DPL about 95% done in branches, Frame relay mostly in

Flaherty spent a lot of time on location tables and location addresses due to miscommunication and lack of information. It was actually very simple

How to share what others have learned

Thanks to Anaclare and Adriene for all of their help with tables etc.

Consistency amongst DALNET libraries

Cfm identifier use for indexes. Limits and restrictions, currently very inconsistent, Different command line for each catalog./database, Need to be consistent for command line searching. Need to go through them and choose best two character codes, Use Z39.58 common command language - Tech Issues Task Force will review this and make recommendations.

# 5. Horizon Migration

## A. UDM cleanup

Records in collections

Re-index including 049 filed fix (Adriene and Mark)

Move database to production server - scheduled by Ana

Image files

Frame Relay link operational (Theresa Moody)

Fines not displaying on notices (Anaclare)

Item filter 049 implemented, mapping OCLC information (Ana is the DALNET contact) for automatic creation of Horizon item records. Others may want this once it works Sheble would like access to cfm file (George)

### B. Botsford

Needs Acquisitions and Serials training full classes

Could /Diane Palden squeeze them into her training for WSU staff?

DayEnd not running correctly, daily stats not printing correctly (Anaclare)

Working on WebPAC

Some advanced field searching not working

Want help screens from Wayne State (Check with George)

Would like to be able to copy other DALNET libraries Horizon bib records (Adriene helped set up in test)

In-house use on each item stats (NOTIS browses) need it per title, can it be added to item table, or is this an enhancement?

Test and training two months before going live for Group 3 Libraries

## C. WSU

Migration to 5.1 might require several days downtime

Testing 049 import

Continue Acquisitions in NOTIS until Sept., end of fiscal year (lack of FYCL)

Working on procedures and new workflow - add to FAQ like pages to share with other DALNET libraries

Circulation seems to be working well

Positive comments from faculty

Biggest problem with installing PCs and LANs/cabling

Questions from faculty about accessing e-journals, etc., from Imagine

Steve Savage's list of what has been cataloged will be posted on librarian's listsery

Proxy server running, but proxy's whole session - still testing

Had a staff meeting to celebrate, but Louise would like a bigger celebration for all staff

Still running TN3270 session in a window to discharge NOTIS circulated materials

Some circulation status data went across, but not charges linked to patrons or fines/fees

Lack of collection on brief display a problem for WSU and Botsford

D. DPL

About ready to sign off on data conversion

Production planned for May 20

Index problems, not in stafpac conditions, e.g. Testing music score index Hopefully soon,

Ana can start doing data extracts, will likely take eight batches. But don't start loading until DPL sign off (Paul, ALS)

Training teams for major modules, developing workflow and training materials for rest of staff, will start about 4/19 for rest of staff - scheduling, finding space, all is scheduled, fairly full

Two serious deficiencies in the software for DPL:

Limit on large number of copies or locations, only seven items display limit in brief record, no indication from system that there are other copies. DPL has added a message – System should do this somehow, 1.3 MIGHT help resolve this – but we can't see 1.3 yet so we don't know.

In setting up restrictions there is a character limit, can't put all of the agencies into the character restrictions, have to do two searches, e.g. African American, have to separate out branches and main.

Needs a retrospective audit trail for five years from NOTIS Acquisitions, set up as an extracted file or database. Auditors require this. (George) WSU may also need this.

Still working on WebPAC and STAFPAC. Restrictions work fine with combined collections in STAFPAC but not WebPAC. How to do this in WebPAC 1.2? Needs Tim or someone to provide some extended help by checking the file and help do some diagnosis instead of just saying for DALNET (Jeff or George) to take a closer look at tables. Might be Z-server related problems

E. Group 3

DALNET staff planning meeting scheduled for Thursday 4/15

If there are more than 10,000 bib records, can use entire file for test database

Ana needs about 500 records, will explode it to more - for libraries with more than 10,000 bib records

Need to select good records, especially, need to select specific conditions – copy, holding, and item records

ALS will select authority records from DALNET "Master" authority database, unless library has specific authorities they want to see test loaded

Training prior to testing, need practice prior to going live
Adriene gave Jim F. a nice list of things and tables to check
Phyllis needed equipment, and indexing, reporting mechanism for OCLL staff
F. Group 4 - Live by 9/30 Suggestions:

Group 4's should start profiling by the end of April
MAS and Bruce have done this before, data conversion, which should help
Prefer two half-day sessions for profile briefing/preparation

Deadline on forms, then follow up with short review, explain implications Collection v. locations, restrictions implications Manuals don't match (e.g. 4.6) the online tables

Access information for online documentation shared

May not need to bring ALS in for extensive sessions, A&A could do it in shorter sessions

- G. Frame relay, might be close, Sheble needs to work on this with UDM IT staff
- H. Libraries use of NOTIS, how long do they stay on, how long to use staff mode, can mark them suppressed from NOTIS, only display in staff, takes about a month for full cycle.
- I. Acquisitions will continue to require access NOTIS. E.g. Wayne OPAC out by August. Leave icon on user workstations until after 5.1 was suggested. May not be able to set overall guidelines. Encourage people to move off as soon as possible. UDM will not be ready until after re-indexing
- J. WebLUIS migration. Wayne has already removed WebLUIS form their webpage, which now goes directly to WebPAC link to DCAT, WSU needs to take WebLUIS down. Tell DALNET and MRLT libraries to discontinue use of WEBLUIS., put in automatic redirect for others

## 6. Shared Patron Database

Need to gather and store new data elements

DPL will add parent's barcode to minor's record

Age rollover supposedly used to work. ALS is investigating

Consistency on patron record. Common elements refer to Circulation TF

Migrated data v. data input

Ability to include multiple e-mails

New Circulation rep. from DPL: Bob Marcelain replacing Terry Potvin. Louise will notify Circulation chair, Brad B.

Use of RSS authentication system

Discussion of authentication scenarios

Specifications blended - Tech Issues TF will review

Cataloging the databases into Horizon

Different URL's etc. in catalogs

Inability to copy serials prediction records from each other's catalogs, Open issue Where to put patron information during transition, need for birth-date element, DPL has designed very useful screen.

Must include last four digits of SSN, but can have entire number Fast add discussion

DALNET staff need access to all libraries' records and files, passkey Ability to look at data elements Passkey was developed Muir will coordinate
Test v. production
DALNET staff that need change individual passkey

Follow up with Task Force chairs

Muir ask Jeff for the Horizon System Administration minutes, add Muir to TF

All TF chairs should be making sure they send minutes to chair of SC
