DALNET Checklist of Requirements for ILL Software

DALNET needs to determine which *epixtech* ILL software will be the best for a Fall 2001 implementation. DALNET's plans to migrate to Horizon 6.0 and iPAC 1.0 need to be considered. DALNET's participation in the LSTA Grant Project for resource sharing with OWLS and the Suburban Library Cooperative also need to be considered.

With these needs in mind, we have updated our checklist of requirements for ILL software. DALNET expects to make a decision in July 2001, after the software is selected for the grant project.

1. The ILL software works with Horizon 5.3 and 6.0, especially the circulation module, and with iPAC 1.0 and WebPAC 1.3.
2. The ILL software enables the use of broadcast searching across all DALNET Horizon catalogs.
3. There is an operational ILL OCLC interface.
4. DALNET prefers a SUN platform. If a combination NT and SUN platform is required initially, we need a migration path to SUN.
5. If only iRequest (the public component) is available by late summer, DALNET will need it to be operational with either RSS or URSA for the staff component.
6. The ILL software is ISO/IPIG and NCIP compliant, and interfaces with other vendors' ILL systems that are also compliant.
7. The ILL software is compatible with *epixtech's* RPA product, as enhanced for DALNET.
8. There are plans to enhance the ILL software with an interface to NLM's DocLine per the DALNET contract.
