

DID YOU KNOW?

- Wayne State University is the leader of a 13-year-old consortium of about two dozen libraries at area higher education institutions, public libraries, hospital and professional libraries in a 3-county area to share library information on-line.
- The consortium is DALNET, Detroit Area Library Network
- Through a partnership with Ameritech DALNET is expanding the system to include 7 southeast Michigan counties – Wayne, Oakland, Macomb, Monroe, Washtenaw, Livingston and St. Clair creating the Southeast Michigan Information Hub.
- The new Web-based information hub will allow users to access more full-text articles, digitized images and view information from other urban/suburban service providers.
- Guides to information on current topics will be gathered, organized and made available to users at the library, user's homes or offices.
- The technology will adapt to the development of "public kiosks" which will bring information to people without access to home or office computers.
