The CRC met for a work session on 2/27. We worked primarily on updating the CRC version of the assessment rubric that will be used as part of the review process for those programs that do not have assessment data available to review. Moving forward, greater emphasis may ultimately be placed on reviewing assessment plans for all reviews as ARTIS has assumed much of the trends analysis piece in assessment.

We are waiting on final versions of the following reports which we should have very soon.

ANT GSC MHA ENV

We will be meeting on Friday, 4/3 for a regular meeting. We will consider changes to the lead reviewer survey, and plan tasks for the end of year evaluation. With regard to the evaluation, the committee will be especially focused on the efficacy of the completability analysis replacement of employment data, and completion of the assessment plan rubric in place of outdated or missing assessment data. Based on the outcome of the inclusion of these elements this year, we may recommend revision of the handbook for Senate's consideration. We will also be accepting nominations for, and voting on a new chair for the CRC.
