TUITION POLICY (First Reading)

X.X.X POLICY – Establishment of Tuition

The Board of Trustees, as directed by the Community College Act of 1966, under Section 389.123 (b),

“ . . . is authorized to establish and collect tuition and fees for resident and nonresident students”. In consideration of these assigned powers, the following values are accounted for in the setting of tuition and fee collections:

- Operating revenues should not exceed a reasonable cost in the delivery of a community college education
- Establishment of tuition and fees considers revenues from district property millage, state appropriations, and ongoing college reserves.
- Tuition for resident and nonresident students considers relative contribution of state and local revenue subsidy.
- Fees represent the offset of actual course cost.
