Chapel became the setting for the reading of a telegram requesting emergency aid for Christians in Viet Nam. The aid had to be sent in a matter of hours. By chapel the next day, our students put together over \$1800, much of which they had to borrow themselves. Their actions said, "We care."

Millions live without Christ. In four campaigns over half of the MCC student body banded together to share their faith in Christ. They not only contacted over 30,000 people, but sparked the comment that "their behavior, spirit, and manner of living did more than one thousand sermons could have done."
