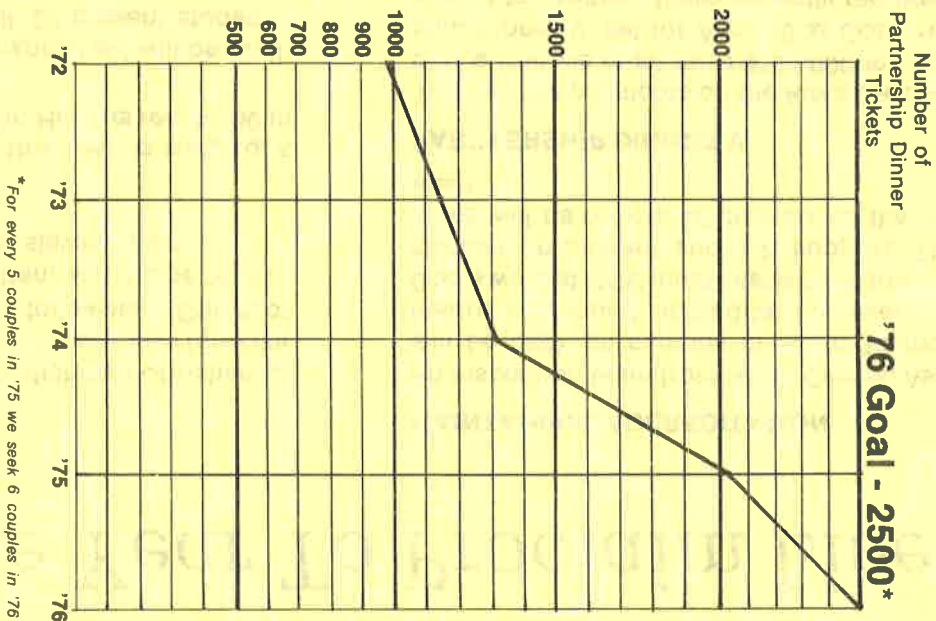

'76 – The Year To Proclaim Liberty

THEME SCRIPTURE

This year's theme scripture at Michigan Christian is: "*...for the Lord hath anointed me...to proclaim liberty to the captives...*" (Isaiah 61:1) As followers of Christ, of whom this passage was written, we pledge to proclaim His gospel of liberty to slaves of sin.

ENCOURAGING TRENDS

- Enrollment, a record 343 this year, is surging, a 45% increase over last year. Help us reach 450 in September.
- Substantial increase in financial aid will be available to applicants this fall. Of present students, 86% receive aid, averaging over \$1600.
- Growing number of able teachers whose foremost quality is Christian commitment.
- Deepening appreciation for God's work at Michigan Christian. After Eldred Echols, missionary in Africa for 32 years, spent a week on campus he wrote, "*The kids there are wonderful...the best advertisement possible for the quality of the college. My daughter, Cherry, solemnly avows she will be at Michigan Christian.*"
- Maturing students are yielding to the Lordship of Christ. During the past semester 12 MCC students were baptized at the Rochester church and 70 students asked for prayers. A recent visitor observed, "*The chapel period was heart-warming. I wish there were some way to transport its uniqueness.*"

MAINTAINING ACCREDITATION

An inspection team from North Central Association will be back on campus in about 12 months. To insure continued accreditation, every friend of God's work at MCC must intensify efforts to increase student enrollment and gift support. These two areas will be of special concern to the inspection team.
