WARRIORS FINISH FIRST IN LEAGUE!



After facing four losses in their first six games, the 1976-77 Warriors pulled themselves together to finish their season with a 15-6 record. Early losses soon changed into an eleven game winning streak, giving the team a 9-1 record in league play. The record resulted in an undisputed first place over Concordia Lutheran College in Ann Arbor, Michigan. MCC also held the unique position of being the only junior college in an otherwise senior college league.

The squad consisted of three returning sophomores and ten freshmen. However, inexperience quickly became minor in the face of good freshmen talent and a strong team spirit. Doug Freeman, a former player for an MCC team, for his first year joined Coach Bill Shinsky in coaching the winning team.

Freshman Kenny Rider, from South Bend, Indiana, led the team in scoring with a 19.2 average in league play. He was followed by freshmen David Rider (14.0), Allen Grant (12.9), and Brian Rose (11.9). Sophomore John Highstreet placed next with a 10.4 average.

Four players made the all-conference team. First team included Kenny Rider; second team, David Rider; and honorable mention, Brian Rose and Allen Grant. David Rider was also selected to the all-tournament team.

Prospects for the 1977-78 season look great with the assured backbone of returning players. Anyone interested in playing on the next winning Warrior squad should contact Coach Freeman at MCC.
