

#### Library given fresh look as renovations continue

Campus renovation projects continued over semester break as employees and volunteers made improvements in the Muirhead Library, business laboratories, and cafeteria. The efforts marked further progress in Dr. Ken Johnson's goal to refurbish the entire campus within a two-year period.

Horace Hill, a library volunteer, sparked the library renovation project by offering to purchase new carpeting for the main hallway and reference room. Before installing new carpeting, workers removed the old floor coverings, resurfaced the ceilings, and painted the walls and trim. As a result of the project, the most visible areas of the library received their first new look since 1974.

In preparation for projected summer improvements in the computer laboratory, college personnel combined the former secretarial and computer labs into one room. The change enabled the scheduling of keyboarding classes on word processors and computers rather than typewriters. It also opened the former secretarial lab for use as a regular classroom.

While workers completed the library and laboratory projects,

cafeteria personnel used their semester break to repaint the entire cafeteria area. The cafeteria has been targeted as a priority among common spaces to receive further improvements in the months ahead.

In order to make significant progress with renovation projects, the college has scheduled a Spring Service Encampment from May 18-29. Volunteers are being sought to assist with a variety of improvement projects, while enjoying campus life with other workers. See page six of this issue for further details.

# Further academic options slated for fall semester

Plans have been finalized for Michigan Christian College to add two new majors to the academic program. While arranging details for those majors, college officials also are preparing for implementation of a four-year business degree and a host of "2+2" programs.

The college plans to begin offering two new majors in the Bachelor of Religious Education program this fall. One major in youth and family ministry and another in missions will be added to current four-year programs in Bible, Christian ministry, and counseling.

After facing months of delay, the college also has put into place another piece of the puzzle necessary to award the Bachelor of Business Administration degree. Steve Williams has been added to the faculty to lead the business program, assisted by an outstanding group of resident and adjunct faculty. These individuals will begin teaching the expanded curriculum this fall.

Initially, the college plans to offer B.B.A. majors in marketing, management, human resources management, and general business. Granting of the B.B.A. is contingent upon final approval of the Michigan Department of Education and the North Central Association. Unofficial conversation with accreditors indicates that final review of the programs will take place in the spring of 1993. Formal approval at that time would enable Michigan Christian College to grant its first B.B.A. degrees in 1994.

Numerous business emphases, besides the four bachelor's level degree plans, also will be available to students under newly developed "2+2" degree plans. The college has initiated the process of building several hundred "2+2" plans that will flow directly into specific bachelor degree programs at about thirty universities in the North Central states. These plans cover a wide variety of academic majors, and are designed to accommodate virtually any high school graduate, regardless of career interest.

The "2+2" degree plans were conceived because of MCC's historically strong belief that the first two years after high school are among the most critical years of a student's life, when most struggle to find their Faith. By following the "2+2" degree plans, neither parents nor students will have to sacrifice the desire for a prestigious degree from a nationally recognized university.

The first two years of each "2+2" degree plan are being specifically tailored to blend with the last two years at a student's institution of choice. However, the plans allow students to spend their first two years of college at the feet of Christian educators who encourage Christian virtues and principles in every aspect of student life. During these two years, students will be able to build relationships and develop the skills needed to significantly enhance their preparedness for eventual leadership roles in the Kingdom.

#### Program growth leads to positive increase in new student interest

We're excited. Good things are happening in every aspect of our work. Without you, our friends, we could not continue. Almost as exciting as the Bachelor of Business Administration degree is the formal development of several hundred specific "2+2" degree plans, which accommodate students in almost any field - from accounting to zoology and from chemistry to computing.

The positive impact on Michigan Christian College from the new B.B.A. programs and the new "2+2" degree plans is expected to be substantial, inasmuch as this dual approach significantly expands the market pool of students willing to consider MCC as a genuine option for all or part of their education. We are already seeing a substantial growth in interest from parents and students who here-to-fore haven't been considering MCC as a viable academic option. As of March 1, new student applications for fall 1992 enrollment are already 16% ahead of the same time last year.

Building quality into every new program, and focusing on quality in every aspect of our work, we'll continue to sharpen our image and refine our reputation for effective service.

#### Business instructor added to faculty

Bringing Michigan Christian College one step closer to the goal of offering the Bachelor of Business Administration degree, Dr. Leonard Knight, academic dean, recently announced the appointment of an additional faculty member to the business department. Steve Williams, a retired major of the United States Air Force, began teaching business for Michigan Christian College in January.

Steve Williams served in fourteen countries during his twenty-one year career with the Air Force. In several locations he taught classes at nearby colleges and universities, accumulating ten years of teaching experience in such places as Nipissing University, Park College, University of Alaska at Anchorage, Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, and University of LaVerne.

Steve Williams earned his bachelor's degrees from Eastern Illinois University and University of the State of New York. He holds a master's degree in human resources management from Houston Baptist University and a master's degree in educational administration from Central Michigan University. He also completed

almost 2,000 hours of specialized training in academic instructional techniques from various schools of the United States Air Force.

With his doctoral dissertation in the final stages of review, Steve Williams plans to receive a Doctorate in Business Administration from Nova University this summer. He entitled his dissertation An Exploratory Research Design to Delineate the Existence of Ingratiatory Behavior in the Workplace.

Steve Williams moved to Rochester Hills shortly after his January 1 retirement from the Air Force. His wife, Kay, is working on campus as a cashier in the Business Office. His oldest son, Terry, is a freshman at Michigan Christian College.

#### Additional aid available to prospective ministers

Students interested in entering the School of Biblical Studies will find a new set of options available to them this fall. The SBS program provides an intensive two-year program of study for those desiring to change careers and enter the ministry.


Since SBS students often are married, plans have been finalized to convert a portion of Palmer Residence Hall into married student housing. Kitchen facilities will be added to the large rooms to make them more functional for couples and families.

In addition to married student housing, campus jobs will be offered to a limited number of spouses. Those securing full-time positions with the college will be eligible to receive health insurance benefits for their families.

Michigan Christian College began operation of the School of Biblical Studies in 1989, after the elders of the Bristol Road Church of Christ in Flint, Michigan, decided to move their program to the campus of MCC. The Bristol Road congregation opened the school in 1970, and continues to provide an advisory committee and scholarships for the program. They have made a commitment to fund six full scholarships for SBS students enrolled in the program this fall.

Although the SBS program is designed to provide specialized training for the ministry, all courses are accepted into the Bachelor of Religious Education degree program. Graduates of the SBS program can enter the ministry after the completion of their two-year program or pursue any of the bachelor degree programs offered by Michigan Christian College.

Dennis Hall, computer center coordinator, received notification in January of his inclusion in the Who's Who Registry.


Kent Hoggatt, director of admissions, conducted his TIPS Communication Seminar in January and February during a fourweek training class at the Livonia Church of Christ.

#### Musical highlights one of February's guest days

Two traditional events highlighted the month of February, as students and off-campus guests shared the activities of Homecoming and Celebration Weekend. Both events combined activities of the student body with additional programs for off-campus guests.

A February 14-15 presentation of South Pacific during Celebration Weekend provided the drama and music departments with an opportunity to produce their first musical since 1979. The stage production, which required the efforts of nearly one-fourth of the full-time student body, temporarily replaced Celebration in Song, which had developed over the previous fifteen years.

In preparation for South Pacific, volunteers began transforming the Westside Central Chapel into a temporary theatre during the break between semesters. Workers removed the fixed seating from the west section of the chapel, and built movable platforms over the seating risers. After classes began, students constructed a curtained stage around the sloped platform, allowing for scene changes. By opening night, the chapel took on a completely new character.

An overflow crowd on Saturday afternoon required the use of video monitors in adjoining rooms for the sponsors of youth groups. Over 800 individuals attended one of the weekend's three performances.

Two Saturdays prior to Celebration Weekend, students and guests shared the activities of Homecoming. Although the alumni began a full day of ac-

tivities during the morning of February 1, the students became actively involved in the day once the Lady Warriors began their afternoon game.

#### Minister begins collection for MCC

Local minister Vernon Boyd recently presented a unique silver communion pitcher to Michigan Christian College as the beginning of a collection of items relating to the history of the churches of Christ in Michigan. Earlier, an unknown individual left the pitcher with a custodian at the Oakland Church of Christ.

Presented to the Cameron Avenue Church of Christ of Detroit by Joseph J. Clutton in 1905, the pitcher was likely used with two chalices. Most churches followed this practice until influenza and tuberculosis epidemics caused them to begin using individual cups.

The original Cameron Avenue congregation began as a mission of the Plum Street Church of Christ in 1893. The congregation secured the Cameron Avenue location in 1903. About 1941, the congregation merged with the former West Side Central church and gave possession of their building to the congregation that currently bears their name.

The college plans to retain the communion pitcher for future display on campus. In the meantime, individuals or churches interested in donating other significant items to a historical collection may contact Vernon Boyd at 28431 Lathrup Boulevard, Lathrup Village, MI 48076.
