Board approves spring ground breaking for new construction

Making a landmark decision for the future of the institution, the Board of Trustees of Michigan Christian College finalized at their June meeting plans to begin construction on new facilities. The board approved of a plan which will allow initial phases of construction to begin as soon as spring weather permits, with a formal ground breaking ceremony on the morning of graduation, May 4, 1996.

"By giving the go-ahead on construction plans, the Board of Trustees is expressing their strong commitment to building a bigger and better college," stated Dr. Ken Johnson, president of the college. "When completed, the project will totally reshape the appearance of the campus, and provide the college's greatest need, additional space for a growing campus population."

College officials launched the Foundation for the Future campaign last spring, designed to provide funding for the \$2.9 million construction project. Currently, approximately one-third

of the goal has been raised, and an aggressive plan to complete the campaign is scheduled.

"Not since the construction of the Alma Gatewood Residence Hall in 1970 has any one fundraising campaign been so vital," commented Bob Utley, chairman of the Board of Trustees. "We need the participation of everyone who is concerned with the future of our young people."

The construction plans include two new residence halls, one for men and one for women, each housing approximately seventy students; a campus commons area that joins the two halls; and a new campus entryway, including necessary changes in roadways and parking areas.

"The new residence halls are a key to future growth at Michigan Christian College," noted Mr. Utley. "They will alleviate overcrowding in the present residence halls and improve the quality of life for all boarding students."

TMP Associates designed the new facility as the first phase of a campus master plan for the

college. Frank Rewold and Son, Inc., a local construction company, provided consulting services in the planning stages. Both firms have established an excellent reputation in the community for their recent design and construction of the Rochester Hills Public Library.

"Over the past year, I have seen a partnership that I have never experienced before. It's great to see a positive vision turn into a powerful alliance of supporters dedicated to the future of Michigan Christian College," stated Mark Davis, vice president for advancement. "This capital expansion represents more than just brick and mortar. It establishes a foundation for continued growth well into the next century, and marks a commitment to long-term growth and stability."



Connection to Internet planned for fall semester

Imagine being linked to over four million computer systems in over 146 countries! By fall, the students of Michigan Christian College will have such resources available to them on campus through the Internet, the most popular vehicle of the information revolution.

"With an average of fifteen sites being added to the Internet daily, the potential data available for

research is enormous," stated Shane Godmere, director of computer support. "Students will be able to do research for papers by accessing thousands of libraries and databases without even leaving their chairs."

College officials recently appears to the state of the

College officials recently announced plans to the student body to proceed with installation of the Internet in campus facilities. This summer, the current IBM compatible workstations in the computer lab will be networked with a Unix operating system in order to allow the college to establish a connection to the Internet.

Along with terminals in the student computer lab, additional terminals will be placed in the Muirhead Library to facilitate Internet access of specialized library resources. Further connections will allow student access to the computer lab network and to the Internet from individual rooms in all of the college residence halls.

The Internet is a rapidly growing web of computer networks. By connecting thousands of independently administered educational, governmental, and commercial networks, the Internet provides individuals and organi-

zations with unlimited opportunities for resource sharing and communication.

On the Internet, students will be able to access university library catalogs, and then obtain additional resources through an interlibrary loan program already administered by the Muirhead Library. In addition, students will find numerous online books and indexes of articles. Many of the articles include full-text and can be printed directly from the Internet.

The Internet also features thousands of databases and an incredible amount of statistical information and reports from governmental, business, scientific, and educational sources. Often such data is more current than printed versions since the material is updated on a more frequent basis.

MCC's connection to the Internet will feature Gopher, a menu-driven navigator, and Netscape, a browsing tool for the World Wide Web that includes full-color graphics and sound, along with text. Mr. Godmere concluded, "Our link to the global community will play a key role in training successful graduates for a vastly changing world."

Internships add depth to programs

"I've been impressed with the level of training the students receive in the counseling program of Michigan Christian College,' stated Rod Linton, residential director of Childplace, a Christian child placement agency in Jeffersonville, Indiana. "MCC graduates have proven themselves prepared to take on professional responsibilities and to be spiritually-minded. Helping troubled children demands $strength\ of\ character\ and\ a\ heart$ of love. MCC students have been equipped with both.

Combining strong academic preparation with on-the-job practical experience, the faculty of Michigan Christian College designed most of the new bachelor's degree programs with a required internship. In an internship, a student receives academic credit for a supervised work assignment in a business, church, or

agency related to their academic program. Internship experiences can be completed any time during the calendar year.
"I'm looking forward to work-

ing with General Motors this summer because the experience I'll receive will be invaluable for my future," commented Natalie Atkinson, a senior marketing student from Lennon, Michigan. Natalie will be interning this summer in the Consumer Relations Aftermarket Division of the GM Service Parts Operation. She will be working with retailers to confirm correct shelving, packaging, and pricing of AC Delco parts. She noted,"Combined with all that I have learned and experienced at MCC, GM is a closer step to the goals I've set.

Filling two key positions in the institution, Dr. Ken Johnson recently announced the addition of Dr. Michael Westerfield and Dr. David Fleer to the employee roster of Michigan Christian College. Dr. Westerfield began duties as administrative vice president in May, and Dr. Fleer will join the faculty in the fall as an associate professor of Bible and communication.

Dr. Westerfield came to Michigan Christian College from York College in York, Nebraska, where he most recently served as administrative vice president. In addition to serving in a broad range of roles for York College, he has served as a consultant/ evaluator for the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools since 1991.

Dr. Mike Westerfield brings to Michigan Christian College a new level of academic leadership and academic experience not equaled in the history of the institution," stated Dr. Ken Johnson. "As he assumes responsibility for much of the campus operation, I'm confident that his emphasis on quality education will take the college to new heights."

Beginning his career at York in 1974 as an instructor of English, Dr. Westerfield began involvement in administrative responsibilities as an assistant to the academic vice president from 1977 to 1986. He then served as vice president for student services from 1987 to 1989, during which time he worked with both the student services and admissions offices. He assumed duties as administrative vice president in 1989.

Dr. Westerfield received an associate degree from York, a Bachelor of Arts from Harding University, a Master of Arts from Pittsburg State University, and a Ph.D. from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln.

Bringing a wealth of academic and ministerial experience, Dr. David Fleer will move to Michigan Christian College from Vancouver, Washington. He has published a number of articles and book reviews, and has spoken on lectureship programs at Abilene Christian University, Pepperdine University, and Columbia Christian College.

"Dr. Fleer is widely recognized among personnel of our Christian colleges as a superb communicator of God's word," noted Dr. Johnson. "I predict that he will be an extremely popular teacher. He also has the potential to bring the college's Bible Department a measure of national recognition not achieved since the early days of the institution."

Following a successful appearance with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra last fall, the Michigan Christian College A Cappella Chorus recently received an invitation to return next season for a February series with the orchestra. Joe Bentley, director of the chorus, stated, "Officials at Orchestra Hall were very impressed not only with the musical prowess of our students, but also with their personal skills and the way they handled themselves both on and off stage."

Last year, the chorus was selected to perform with the Wayne State University Chorale and the Madrigal Chorale of Southfield as vocal accompaniment for one of the symphony's popular pops concerts. Both the symphony organizers and the guest conductor, the world renowned Eric Kunzel, specifically requested that the MCC chorus return for the only pops concert scheduled for the next season.

"This is a wonderful learning experience for our students," commented Mr. Bentley. "Being invited to sing with a world-class ensemble like the Detroit Symphony Orchestra represents a strong validation of the skills our singers have developed, and speaks to the excellent reputation the A Cappella Chorus has gained in the arts community."

Athletes face stronger competition

Speaking to his basketball team in a pregame session last season, Coach Ron Hammye of Wayne State University warned his players to not underestimate their competition by stating, "Michigan Christian College is one of the best coached teams in the state of Michigan. You will not find student athletes that playany harder than the men who play for Michigan Christian.' The Warriors of MCC left that basketball game within four points of defeating Wayne State University, an NCAA Division II school with an enrollment of over 20.000 students!

As Coach Hammye later stated to an employee of MCC, "You play a difficult and competitive schedule, but you are equal to the task!" Such comments surfaced frequently during the past season as Michigan Christian College stepped up its competition level. The season included games with other NCAA colleges and universities like Oakland University, Northern Michigan University, and Adrian College, and NAIA institutions like Siena Heights College and Madonna College. In other areas of athletic competition, Michigan Christian College hosted and participated in three national tournaments for the NSCAA during the 1994-95 academic year. Teams from several states traveled to the

campus for finals in cross country, volleyball, and soccer.

The women's cross country team from MCC took second place in the nationals, and the soccer team took third. Based upon a positive response to last year's events, the association plans for MCC to host all three tournaments again next season.

In Memoriam - Jerry Philpot II

Jerry Philpot, a Detroit police officer and 1986 graduate of Michigan Christian College, was fatally shot while on duty May 25, 1995. During his life, Jerry received several citations and awards from the army and his department. Over 2,000 individuals, including about 1,000 police officers from Michigan, Ohio, Indiana, and Ontario, honored Jerry at funeral services at the Allen Park Church of Christ. The Detroit News stated, "Jerry F. Philpot II's longtime dream was to become a police officer, but even when he accomplished that, his family was always first in his mind. He even carried a picture of his daughter, Katelyn, where his police I.D. should have been placed." The class of 1986 and Jerry's widow, Diane, have established an endowed scholarship for criminal justice students at Michigan Christian College in honor of Jerry.

Honoring a former student of Michigan Christian College with the highest civic award in the state of Indiana, Governor Evan Bayh recently honored Dean Moore with the Sagamore of the Wabash Award. The state recognized Dean for twenty-one years of community service with the United Way.

Dean graduated from Michigan Christian College in 1962. Reflecting upon his experience at MCC, Dean stated, "The small college atmosphere provided several avenues for cultivating leadership skills. Translating such experiences into career practice was a natural." He continued, "The emphasis on service to others was a guiding force in my career choices.

After leaving college, Dean preached for two congregations, and served as business manager for both the Shults-Lewis and Midwestern Children's Homes. After four years as director of campaigns and public relations for the Southwestern Ohio Lung Association, he began his work

Dean and his wife, the former Mary Branstetter, also a 1962 graduate of MCC, both serve on the Development Council of Michigan Christian College. In 1992, the couple organized a very successful reunion for their class.

The Chesterton Tribune quoted several comments made by Indiana Senator Bill Alexa at the award presentation. Senator Alexa commented, "For his entire professional life, Dean has devoted his energy and talents to

helping people.

Senator Alexa also noted that under Dean's capable leadership, the United Way of Porter County "has developed many innovative and creative programs regarded by his peers at the cutting edge of philanthropy." The newspaper added, "Despite its modest size, Porter County's United Way is viewed by many professionals



Alumni establish annual service day

Building upon the success of two previous campus improvement projects, the Alumni Association sponsored Alumni Service Day on June 3. Association leaders scheduled the day with intentions to make it an annual event for volunteers.

In 1992, twenty-two individuals donated over 600 hours of labor over the summer to completely renovate the area used by the music department, now named the Alumni Music Center. In the late summer of 1992, forty-one volunteers participated in a service day which assisted with improvement projects.

"Realizing the positive impact that our previous efforts had on the appearance of the campus, we decided to develop a service day as an annual event," stated Rob Clarke, president of the Alumni Association. "Since we had proceeds from last year's Fall Festival Steerburger Booth available and planned to continue that project, we decided to use those proceeds to purchase materials for a service day project."

After considering a number of possibilities, the alumni leadership eventually decided to focus their efforts on the Chinese Gardens, a landscaped area near Gallaher Center that predates the college. Over the years, both the students and alumni have developed a sentimental attachment to the beautiful setting.

Looking at the Chinese Gardens as a potential long-term project, alumni leaders directed their efforts toward a first phase of improvements on June 3. They filled the old pools, which had become impractical to maintain,

and prepared separate areas for seeding and flower beds. Maintaining as much of the original landscaping as possible, they developed the area into an attractive rock garden.

Harwell speaks at P.D.

Guests of Partnership Dinner XXIII enjoyed a unique experience as they met and listened to Ernie Harwell, famed sportscaster for the Detroit Tigers. Over 1,200 individuals gathered at the Cobo Civic Center for the annual event.

"We were thrilled to have Ernie agree to participate," stated Phil Conner, director of the campaign. "Many have commented that they could have listened to him all night because he brought back fond memories which had been long forgotten."

After stints with the Brooklyn Dodgers, New York Giants, and Baltimore Orioles, Harwell began his thirty-two year career with the Detroit Tigers. Since his induction as the first sports-caster in the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, New York, he has been inducted into six additional Halls of Fame. Sports Illustrated named him as radio announcer for their All-Time Dream Team, and local sports enthusiasts have selected him as Michigan Sportscaster of the Year on fifteen occasions.

With a total of 1,580 ticket sales, including matching gift funds, dinner attendance increased by 11% over the previous year. Sixty congregations participated in the campaign.

Gift clubs restructured

Expanding the number of gift clubs from three to seven, the Development Office recently introduced a revised system of donor recognition. Along with other discussions, the groups provided valuable input about the location and speakers for Partnership Dinner, and proposed an alumni business card exchange, which two members volunteered

to develop into an on-line directory of professional services available from former students of the college.
