Some Facts You Should Know About Michigan Christian College

WHAT KIND OF COLLEGE IS MICHIGAN CHRISTIAN COLLEGE?

MCC is a liberal arts junior college emphasizing Christian ideals. Although not organically connected with any religious body, the college receives its principle support from members of the churches of Christ. Students from any religious faith may attend.

WHY SHOULD I GO TO A CHRISTIAN COLLEGE?

A Christian college offers many special benefits. Christian teachers take a special interest in each student. Clean, wholesome recreation offers every student opportunity for social development. Bible classes and chapel, as well as Christian fellowship, encourage spiritual development. Life-long friendships, bound firmly by common interests are an extra reward of life at a Christian college.

IS MICHIGAN CHRISTIAN COLLEGE ACCREDITED?

MCC is approved by the Michigan Department of Public Instruction and is listed in Part 3 of the Educational Directory in the Office of Education, U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare. Appropriate agencies have approved the college for the education of veterans and the training of foreign students. MCC holds membership in the American Association of Junior Colleges, Michigan Association of Junior and Community Colleges, North Central Council of Junior Colleges and National Commission on Accreditation.

WILL I BE ABLE TO TRANSFER CREDITS TO ANOTHER COLLEGE?

Students have transferred credits to almost sixty colleges and universities in the United States. If your grades are satisfactory, you will experience no difficulty in transferring credits.

HOW MANY JUNIOR COLLEGE CREDITS MAY I TRANSFER TO A SENIOR COLLEGE?

In most cases, a maximum of 96 quarter hours (64 semester hours) are transferable to a senior

college. 96 quarter hours are normally acquired during a 2-year (6 quarters) period.

WHAT COURSES ARE AVAILABLE?

Courses are offered in nine major divisions; Bible, Business Education, Education and Psychology, Engineering and Mathematics, Fine and Applied Arts, Language and Literature, Natural Sciences, Physical Education and Social Sciences. Students are able to receive a broad general education program which will prepare them to do upper division work at a senior college.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO ATTEND MCC?

Tuition for an average academic load will cost approximately \$240 per quarter. Books and fees will increase this cost slightly. Seldom will the total cost be more than \$300. Boarding students pay \$206 per quarter for meals and room.

ARE FINANCIAL AIDS AVAILABLE?

The college participates in the National Defense Student Loan program and provides other loans for students. Scholarships are available to students who qualify and part-time student employment helps defray college expenses for many students.

WHAT GRADE AVERAGE IS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION?

Normally, students may be admitted with a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average. Otherwise, applications may be considered on an individual basis and, in some cases, admission granted with probationary restrictions.

WHAT HIGH SCHOOL SUBJECTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION?

Assuming that grades are satisfactory, a student may qualify for admission on the basis of graduation from an accredited high school. You are strongly urged to take a college preparatory program in high school.

IS AN ENTRANCE EXAM REQUIRED?

The ACT is recommended to help college officials predict the probable degree of success for each

applicant. This test, however, is not required. All new students take a standard placement test as a part of the enrollment procedure.

WHEN SHOULD I APPLY?

Although there is no application deadline, ample time must be allowed for processing. You are strongly urged to apply ninety days to one year prior to the time you intend to enroll.

WHEN SHOULD TRANSCRIPT BE SENT?

When you send your application for admission, you should request your high school principal or counselor to send a copy of your official transcript showing grades for courses completed and include a list of courses in progress. When grades for the final semester are available, a supplementary transcript should be sent. Transfer students should follow the same procedure with regard to college transcripts. In some cases, transfer students will also be required to have high school transcripts sent.

DOES MICHIGAN CHRISTIAN COLLEGE PARTICIPATE IN INTER-COLLEGE SPORTS?

MCC is a member of the Michigan Christian College Athletic Association. The college participates in regularly scheduled league and tournament basketball competition. In addition to inter-collegiate competition, the college provides opportunity for participation in a variety of intramural sports such as touch football, softball, volleyball, badminton, etc.

WHAT ABOUT EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES?

A number of student activities play important roles in college life. Several traditional social events characterize the school year . . . banquets, class parties, etc. Among organizations which fulfill extracurricular interests are: Student Government, College Newspaper, Yearbook, A Cappella Chorus, Dramatics, Religious Organizations, Special Interest Clubs and others.
