***COACH.** The selection of Jim Clary as the Warriors' coach is an indication of a desire to bring a new excellence to the basketball program at MCC. Coach Clary has thirteen years of coaching experience in the public schools, where his teams have been noted for their exciting style of play. He has developed a sound and successful program at each place he has coached. Enthusiasm, desire, and hustle are the attributes Clary gives for success. He promises that the Warriors will be a very exciting and interesting team to watch and that MCC will have one of the finest junior college programs in the Midwest.

***STUDENT SUPPORT.** The student body at MCC has a reputation for supporting their team. Often they even outnumber the other teams' fan section at the away games! The Cheerleaders and Warriorettes form an automatic nucleus of fans at every game during the year. ***FACILITY.** The Warriors play their home games in the Rochester High School Gymnasium, which seats about 2,000 fans. Plans are being made to renovate MCC's practice gym. Improvements include the addition of two glass backboards and four practice backboards on the side; resurfacing of the playing floor; and construction of a team room, showers, and a basketball office.

***LOCATION.** Rochester, a beautiful community in greater Detroit, is MCC's home. We have the cultural, educational, and entertainment advantages of one of the nation's largest cities at hand while enjoying the privileges of suburban living. On campus, two lakes, woods, and gardens provide a peaceful "resort-like" atmosphere for students to enjoy.

***SCHEDULE.** MCC is a member of the North Central Christian College Athletic Conference. The Warriors normally play about twenty regular season games plus the Christian College Classic, NCCAA Tournament, and the Harding College Invitational Tournament. The best junior colleges in the Midwest will be added to the Warriors' schedule in the near future. To be good you must play the best and we plan to be the best!

***PLACEMENT.** We will be active in helping our athletes to acquire jobs to continue their education at other institutions. To us you are not a number, you are a member of the family.
