

Semester break provided an occasion for the MCC A Cappella Chorus to travel to Searcy, Arkansas for the annual Christian College Choral Festival. The MCC Chorus participated in the festival with seventeen other choruses, representing fifteen Christian colleges.

The combined chorus, made up of over eight hundred singers, spent several hours in rehearsal with Dr. Howard Swan, a noted choral conductor from Los Angeles, California. On Saturday evening, the combined chorus presented a spectacular performance in addition to selections by the individual groups.

En route to Arkansas, the chorus appeared in Cincinnati, Ohio. On the return trip to Michigan, they performed for churches in St. Louis, Missouri and Indianapolis, Indiana, as well as the Indianapolis Christian School.
