

## Warriors achieve a smashing 23-3 season record



Sporting a 22-2 season record and number two ranking in the National Little College Association, the MCC Warriors entered the North Central District Tournament in Orchard Lake, Michigan on March 1. In the first game of the playoffs, the Warriors soundly defeated Nazareth College of Nazareth, Michigan by a score of 68-34.

In the championship game of the tournament, MCC faced St. Mary's College of Orchard Lake, a team which also plays in NAIA competition. Although the Warriors fell to St. Mary's in overtime by a score of 59-55, the game included one of the most exciting moments in MCC basketball history.

Trailing by four points with eight seconds left in the game, the Warriors gained two points when Greg Spraggins of Howell, Michigan made two free throw shots. In the remaining three seconds of the game, Todd Grizzell of Pleasant Ridge intercepted the ball in bounds and passed it to Iantham Alleyne of Barbados, West Indies. Alleyne immediately shot the ball from half court before the buzzer sounded with the ball in the air. The ball then dropped in the basket, resulting in a 48-48 tie which had to be broken.

"Today's secretary can get by with a little less penmanship, but they had better be prepared for an electronic future." So began a recent article in *The Detroit News* on February 11. The article continued by stating that local secretaries with word processing skills have twice the chance of getting a job as compared with a year ago. It also cited national survey results indicating a five-fold increase since 1982 in the number of jobs requesting experience or interest in word processing.
