

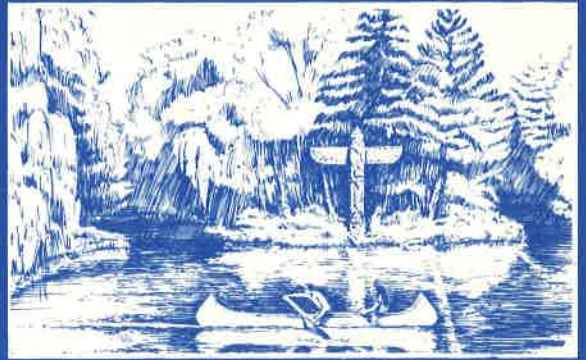

## Campus comes alive as students arrive for MCC's 27th year

Responding to a question on her Application for Admission about relatives who had attended MCC, freshman Julie Kreh of Searcy, Arkansas, stated, "See attached list." Commenting on Julie's decision to attend MCC in spite of the fact that they live in a college town, her mother stated in a letter, "We are pleased that . . . she still prefers to attend our 'Alma Mater.'" In fact, Julie's cousin, William Blake of Littleton, Colorado, is also continuing a family tradition since he already has applied for admission for the fall of 1986.

Another incoming freshman, Anita Waggoner of Selma, Alabama, "returned home" as she arrived in Rochester to attend MCC this fall.
