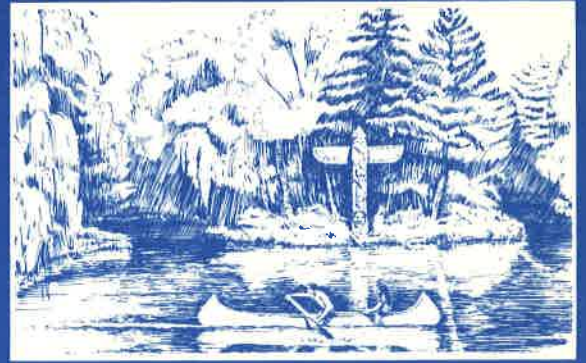

Business program expansion highlights new academic year

Campus hummed with activity throughout the summer as college employees prepared for the opening of Michigan Christian College's 29th academic year. A new scheduling system permitted longer vacation time for the students and two more weeks of preparation on campus.

Summer improvements included major reorganization of the Muirhead Library. After substantial moving of materials, space opened for a new Business Education Lab. The lab includes all current business holdings and space for new materials being added to the library in support of the expanded business program.

One week before the residence halls officially opened, members of the women's volleyball team began arriving on campus. Team members participated in a week of intensive practice before their first match on September 10. The remainder of the student body began arriving on Saturday, September 5. Within days, members were selected and practice began for the performing groups, the A Cappella Chorus, Autumn, and Company, as well as the other fall sports, cross country and soccer.

Fall registration included the first students to enroll as juniors in the new Expanded Business Program. This program is designed to serve students through their junior year of college until approval is obtained from the State of Michigan and the North Central Association for a full Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.) degree. Students completing MCC's Expanded Business Program will be able to complete their bachelor's degree with approximately one year of additional work at one of several participating colleges and universities. Possible majors include Accounting, Computer Information Systems, Economics, Management, Marketing, and Office Management.

States and countries represented in the fall student body include Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, New York, Ohio, Texas, Wisconsin, Austria, Japan, Nigeria, Saskatchewan, and the Virgin Islands.

At a Glance

Does it still pay to go to college? According to federal statistics quoted in a September 16 article of the *Detroit News*, those with a college degree earn a median income of \$22,000. This compares to less than \$16,000 for those with only a high school education. The article also pointed out that college is much more than learning an occupation. "It's about learning how to learn, how to think critically, how to prepare for life's inevitable changes."

Academic and ACT Scholarship recipients will receive larger awards next fall. For a 3.00 to 3.33 grade average in high school, students will receive \$600 per academic year, 3.34 to 3.66, \$800, and 3.67 to 4.00, \$1000. For an ACT composite score of 21 to 24, students will receive \$600 per academic year; 25 to 28, \$800; and 29 to 36 \$1000. Students may choose the higher of these two awards if eligible for both and may renew scholarships for subsequent years based upon college grades.

Fathers joined their daughters on campus for a September 25 banquet held in their honor. The following day, the Student Body Association hosted a retreat at Michigan Christian Youth Camp. The day included activities and discussion sessions designed to assist the students in getting better acquainted.
