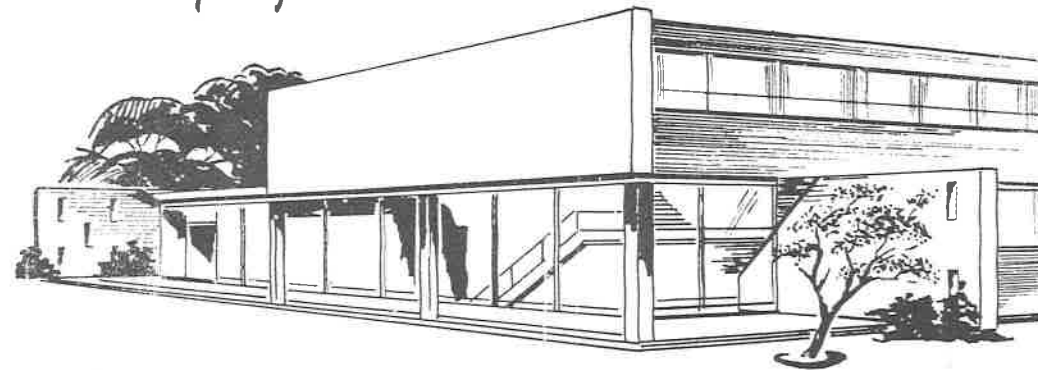
A WORD ABOUT NCCC
