

What is the President's Circle?

The President's Circle is an informally organized group of deeply interested individuals, businesses, and foundations who believe wholeheartedly in Christian education, and especially in Michigan Christian College. Their conviction is evidenced by a gift of \$1,000 or more during the calendar year. Members of the President's Circle contribute approximately 62% of the total gifts to the institution.

What does the President's Circle do?

The men and women of the President's Circle give evidence to their tangible concern for the growth and development of Michigan Christian College from a financial standpoint. These friends of the College are also deeply concerned about spiritual stability. They do not stand on the sidelines and avoid involvement. They take the leadership roles in various volunteer groups; they invest their time; they offer advice; they reflect public feelings; they suggest improvements in procedures and methods; and they encourage students to attend.

How long has the President's Circle been in existence?

The President's Circle, as a recognized group, was organized and brought to the forefront in early 1981. Even before that, however, each of the Presidents of Michigan Christian College has had a select group of individuals to turn to for advice and financial support. These good people have worked quietly, without fanfare, in a "behind-the-scenes" format across the years.

What are the goals of members of the President's Circle?

- 1. To assist in improving the quality of Michigan Christian College in its academic offerings and physical facilities.
- To assist in positively affecting the character of men, women and families in the church, community, nation and the world.

The fulfillment of these goals is almost incomprehensible, but possible. The task must begin somewhere! We believe that Michigan Christian College is a good starting point.

What are the benefits of becoming a member of the President's Circle?

The greatest benefit is to know that you have participated at a high level in the development of and the sustaining of an institution dedicated to changing lives for good. In a world that is beset by a divorce rate of 50%, where pornography is sold alongside bread and milk, where alcoholism and drug abuse have even reached down into the elementary grades, we believe that a Christian education at the various formal levels, coupled with that in the church and home, is the only answer.

However, in a very mundane way, to show appreciation to each President's Circle member, a token gift is made to members on an annual basis.

Also, each year you are a member of the President's Circle, you are invited by the President (the following fall) to the annual President's Circle Dinner held during the Bible Lectureship Week in early October.

How do I become a member of the President's Circle?

Gifts to all MCC giving programs and/or designations apply toward President's Circle membership. Gifts must total at least \$1,000 by December 31 of a given calendar year to qualify one for membership.
