Other Special Programs Offered by Michigan Christian College

Christian Ministry Workshops. Each year, weekend workshops are presented by teams of employees from Michigan Christian College and other volunteers in congregations throughout the Midwest. These workshops cover a wide range of topics related to the work and growth of the local church.

Mission Emphasis. Groups of enthusiastic Michigan Christian College students often travel throughout the Midwest on weekends or during their spring break to assist congregations with personal evangelism campaigns, special Bible school programs, or service projects.

Bible Lectureship. Each October, outstanding speakers from throughout the country and hundreds of guests converge on campus for the annual Michigan Christian College Lectureship.

Jim Wood Church Leaders Workshop. A special program for church leaders and those aspiring to be church leaders is hosted on campus in the summer in order to strengthen the leadership of the church in the Midwest.

Youth Leaders Workshop. Bible class teachers, volunteer youth workers, church leaders, and youth ministers are invited to the campus in the fall for a program aimed at methods of guiding Christian youth.

What is a Christian Education Sunday?

Every year, scores of congregations among the churches of Christ are visited by representatives of Michigan Christian College. These representatives present a gospel sermon on either a Sunday morning or a Sunday evening and often teach a Bible class as well. Since a portion of time is set aside during each visit for comments about Christian Education, these special visits have been designated as Christian Education Sundays.

Why Does MCC Offer Christian Education Sundays?

Serving the churches of Christ in the Midwest has been a primary goal of Michigan Christian College since its inception in 1959. Over the years, the pulpits of hundreds of congregations have been filled on special occasions from the rich resource of speakers available at the college.

In 1981, the college developed a formal program of Christian Education Sundays to broaden the availability of such speakers to more churches and to further highlight the benefits of Christian Education. Since that time, speakers from Michigan Christian College have participated in Christian Education Sundays on over 550 occasions.

How Can Your Congregation Benefit from a Christian Education Sunday?

When you host a Christian Education Sunday at your congregation, you will be enriched by a man with years of preaching experience and the insight of an individual who has committed himself to the training of Christian youth. You will expose your young people to the unique opportunities available to them when they choose a Christian Education.

What is MCC's Role in a Christian Education Sunday?

- MCC's Director of Development will schedule the date for a speaker to visit your congregation.
- Your appointment will be confirmed in writing and you will receive biographical information about the speaker.
- A gospel sermon will be presented during the worship period on the scheduled date.
- During the Bible class period or the time of your choice, information on the growth and progress of the college will be presented. The presentation also will highlight current events sponsored by the college.

What is Your Role in a Christian Education Sunday?

- You may contact the President's Office or the Development Office to schedule a speaker for a Christian Education Sunday at your congregation.
- You will arrange for any audio visual equipment that might be needed by the speaker.
- You will advertise the Christian Education Sunday among members of your congregation.
- You will provide lodging and/or other accommodations for the speaker if needed.

Milton B. Fletcher. President of MCC and regular speaker for special events who has served as a Christian college administrator since 1960 and also has served as an elder.

Leo Hindsley. Former missionary to France and minister in local congregations who now teaches Church History at MCC.

Kent Hoggatt. Director of Admissions at MCC and special occasion speaker who also provides services as a professional speech consultant.

Michael Houston. Teacher of Bible and Biblical Languages at MCC with experience in preaching, campus ministry, and youth ministry.
