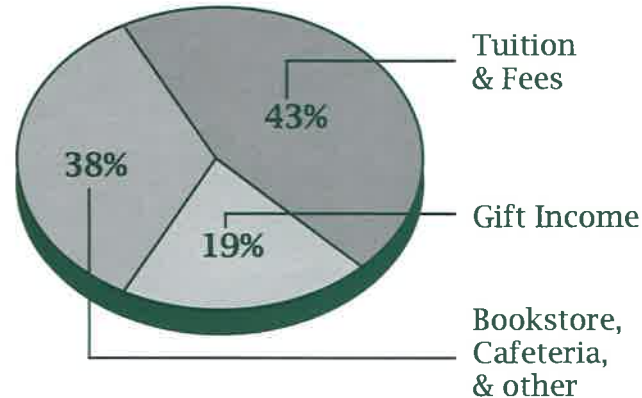

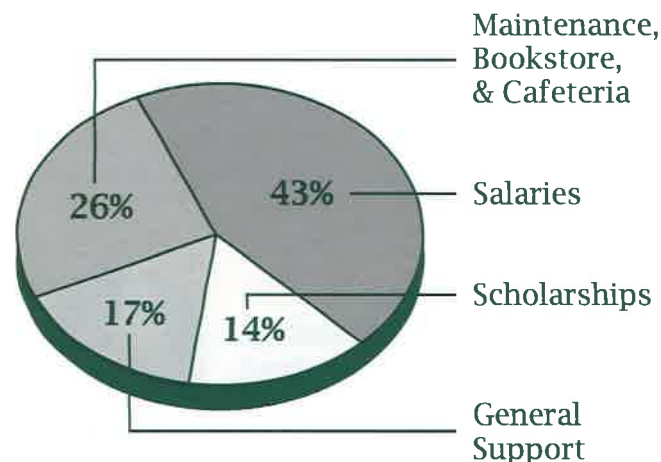
Finances
