Length of Program

Each person is different depending on how many credits are being transferred (if any) and what pace you decide to set for yourself.

Associate degrees are generally considered to be 2-year degrees; however, under the accelerated format you could finish the degree much quicker depending upon your individual circumstance and how many credits you are transferring into the program.

Those who are seeking courses necessary for entrance or completion of bachelor degree programs may take those courses from the associate degree program.

Enrollment Requirements

Regular admission is granted if you are at least 23 years of age, have 5 or more years of work experience, and have a high school diploma (2.0 GPA) or GED (minimum score of 50), or if you are transferring 17 or more credit hours (2.0 GPA).

Provisional admission may be granted to students under the age of 23 who otherwise meet the minimum academic standards and are not enrolled in the traditional program. To be provisionally admitted, you must document work and/or life experience supporting your application to an adult accelerated program.
