In September 1959 North Central Christian College opened its doors to 54 students. Two years later the name was changed to Michigan Christian Junior College and eventually renamed Rochester College in an effort to reflect its liberal arts offering of 38 undergraduate degrees and one master's program. For the past fifty years the college has thrived on Avon Road in Rochester Hills. Today, approximately 1,000 students utilize the 80 acre campus and the college boasts nearly 6,000 alumni worldwide.




January 10, 2009: Christian College Choral Festival
